

# A.C.S.C. MEETING MINUTES SOS SPRING SAFARI NORTH MYRTLE BEACH, SC SATURDAY, APRIL 25, 2015

# I. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Ken Akin called the Association of Carolina Shag Clubs Spring Safari meeting to order at North Myrtle Beach, SC on Saturday, April 25<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m. Meeting Agenda was Approved. Ken introduced the A.C.S.C. Officers, S.O.S. Board Members, and S.O.S. Officers. Absent was Dr. Phil Sawyer, who sends his kindest regards to everyone. Ken also introduced the S.O.S. Webmaster Mary Gregory. S.O.S. Photographers, Vickie and Paul Harrison were not able to attend today's meeting, but Mary will take photos in her place. Ken announced that we have reached over 7,000 on our Facebook page and how exciting that we have continued interest and growth.

# II. A.C.S.C. SECRETARY'S REPORT

Minutes from the 2015 January Mid-Winter Workshop were presented by Lisa Caveny. This was the first combined Winter meeting held at North Myrtle Beach. There were no changes. Motion to accept the minutes made and seconded. Minutes were Approved.

#### III. A.C.S.C. TREASURER'S REPORT

The A.C.S.C. Financial Report was presented by Treasurer, Allen Henry. Allen mentioned that he would be immediately mailing out late notices to those who have not paid their 2015 dues. Looking at our treasurer's report dated 3/31/15, the beginning balance on 1/01/15 of \$18,524.93, net receipts of \$12,676.14, and expenses of \$11,569.63, for a Balance of \$19,631.44. Question (Mike Rink) from the floor as to why the Jr. Shag Association had not been paid their disbursement of \$2,000. Allen explained that a phone call had already been made, and that they are in the process of submitting their expense voucher. There was further discussion that before money could be disbursed from the Association, a voucher showing expenses had to be submitted for record keeping purposes. Ken added that he had also had a conversation with Gene Pope, and there was agreement that a paper trail was important due to questions that may arise from disbursements of Association funds. Allen assured everyone that as soon as a 2015 invoice reaches his hand, the check for \$2,000 will be mailed to the Jr. Shag Association. # IV. A.C.S.C. CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

Ken entertained from the floor any bids for the 2017 Summer Workshop by District A. Lake Norman Shag Club responded that they will be prepared to make a formal presentation at the Summer Workshop.

Ken introduced Dewitt Hinson, of Shag Atlanta, who was instrumental in the Atlanta Olympics. Dewitt was promoting the 20<sup>th</sup> Reunion of Shagging in the Olympics. He was selling copies of a DVD of highlights of the only time in history when shaggers danced during an Olympic event.

Ken called up Judy Bennett, Co-Chair of the ICON selection committee to present the trophies for our 2015 ICON recipients.

She is our resident artist, and lends her talent to creating the wonderful covers for our Carefree Times each S.O.S. Milton is best known for Pirates Cove, one of our favorite spots to dance. Helen presented both a Lifetime Achievement Award for their continued contributions and efforts in promoting and preserving our dance. A lovely plaque was presented in recognition of their hard work and contributions.

Helen reminded everyone that there are a few hardback books by Dr. Phil Sawyer available at the Company Store.

Helen announced that Vickie and Paul Harrison have given up their positions as S.O.S. photographers due to Vickie's health issues. The announcement was made that Jim Allen, a North Myrtle Beach photographer will take over as our official photographer. Paul Harrison may continue to help out when his schedule allows. Helen thanked those board members who are helping out during this transition.

Helen announced there are 330 plus shaggers heading out in October to S.O.S. at Sea on Royal Caribbean "Independence of the Seas". If others are interested, Michael Graham with Cruise Planners, is still handling bookings and willing to answer questions.

Helen shared an email from an Association member reminding us how the friendships made through the Association and S.O.S., helped her during a tough time. The email was written by Joan Kimbro, President of Burlington Shag Club, expressing her appreciation for the outpouring of concern and love for her during her time of healing from her accidental fall during S.O.S. It reminds us all the value of caring for one another, and it comes from a lady

who always shows her love and support for others.

Ron Whisenant, President of S.O.S., came forward and gave his report on S.O.S. Membership card sales for 2015.

Ron reported:

Shag Club Totals: 3,204 for a total of \$96,120 Beach Club Totals: 2,264 for a total of \$67,920 Internet and Mail Totals: 273 for a total of \$9,555.

Totals for 2015 so far are: for a total of \$173,595

Ron expressed his sadness of the death of Pat Smith. He assured everyone that the work would continue in order to keep up with the demands of the Registrar's position. Ron thanked all the clubs for their continued efforts in selling S.O.S cards.
