

# A.C.S.C. MEETING MINUTES SOS SPRING SAFARI NORTH MYRTLE BEACH, SC SATURDAY, APRIL 23, 2016 

## I. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Ken Akin called the Association of Carolina Shag Clubs Spring Safari meeting to order at North Myrtle Beach, SC on Saturday, April $23^{\text {rd }}$ at 10:00 a.m. Meeting Agenda was Approved. ## III. A.C.S.C. TREASURER'S REPORT
