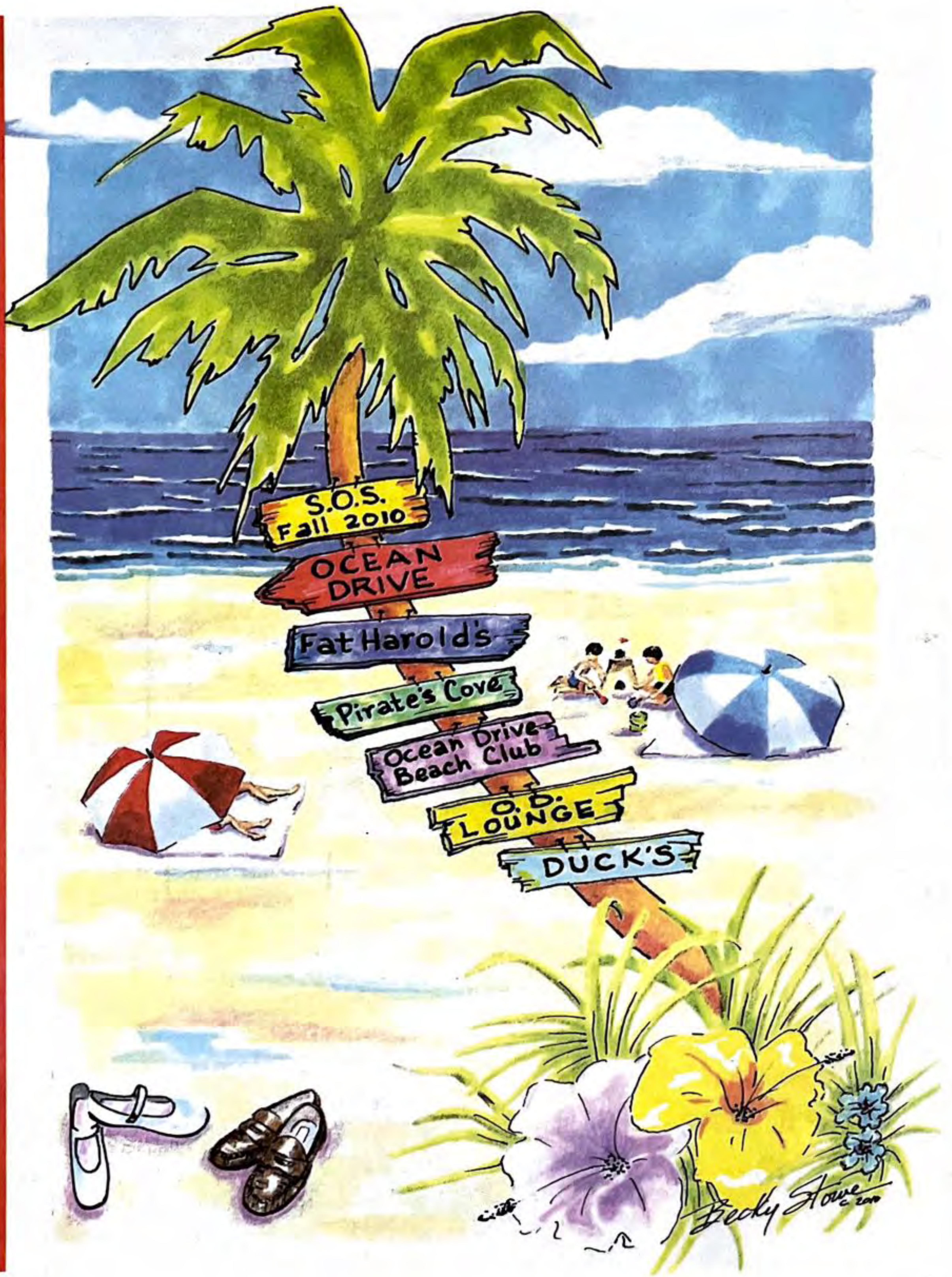

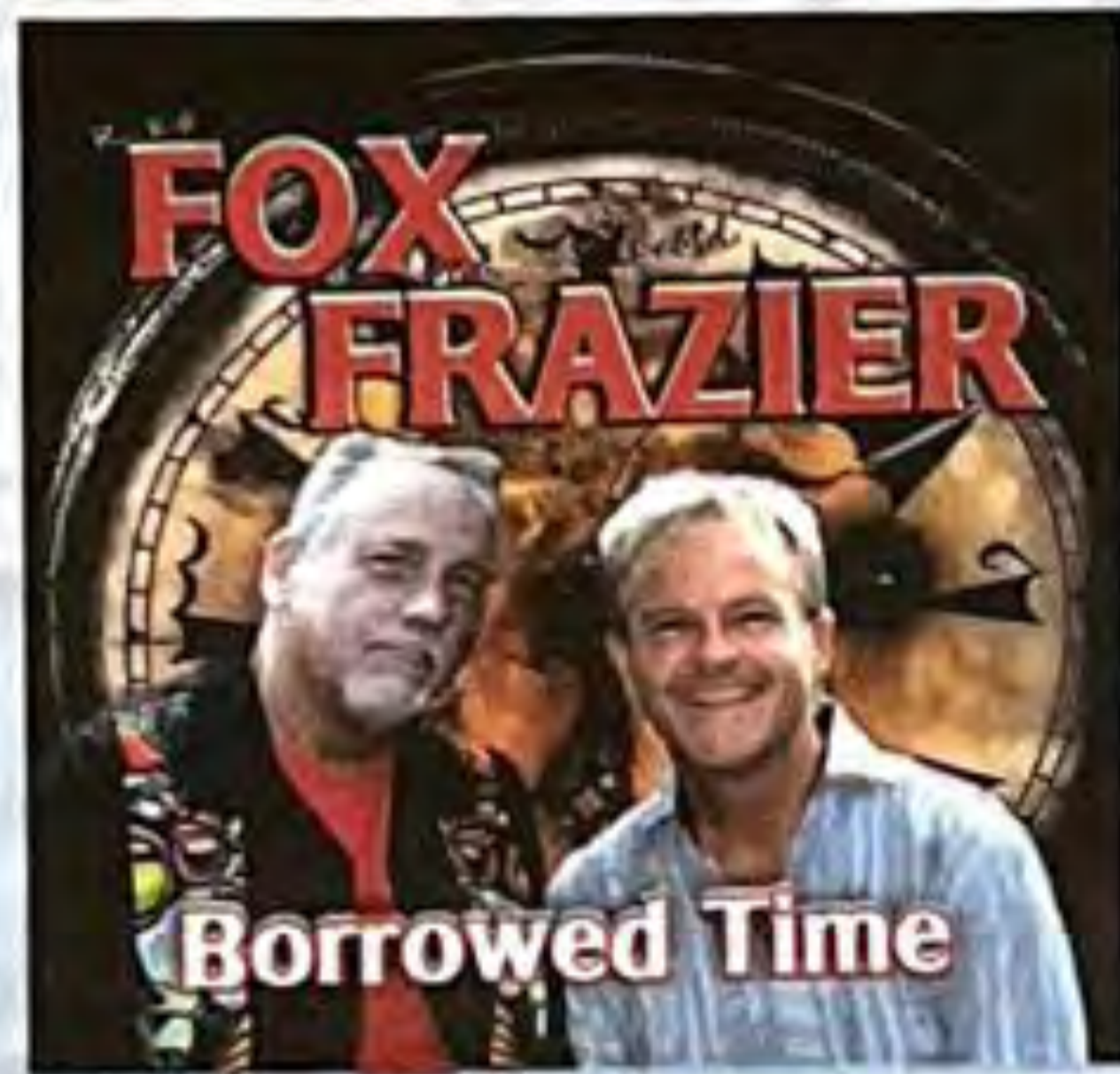

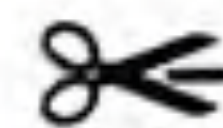

## Welcome Shaggers

If you are a sun lover and like to spend time on the beach, you realize how important an umbrella or tent is to give shade from the heat of the sun, and to prevent blistering of the fair skinned visitors that take to the beach. The use of an umbrella is very important to the beach person.

Tents that would popup came along a few years ago, and began to populate the beach. As they grew in popularity, they also began to present problems. When a family or group came to the beach, they pitched the tent, and left it pitched for the duration of their vacation or stay. This became a problem for the Sanitation Department which is charged with the cleanliness of the beach. This crew performs their duties very early in the morning hours before the sunbathers arrive. They sweep the beach with a very large piece of equipment, as well as removal of all trash from the trash

receptacles placed on the beach. The tents left on the beach overnight became a problem to the Sanitation crew. The result became a rule or law that tents, umbrellas, or any structure could not be left on the beach. If it was, it was gone and became property of NMB or trashed as appropriate.

The beach tents have survived by being removed overnight. Now we are facing losing tent privileges because of a popular grouping together of tents, tying several tents together to create a large



covered area to cover sound equipment, sometimes a DJ, coolers, food, and all of the usual party necessities to create a beach party. This grouping of tents, and the locations of these groupings has become the area of focus. Tents grouped or tied together becomes an obstruction in an area that creates an unsafe passage of Emergency equipment, especially near the entrances to the beach areas.

If you want to help save our "Tents on the Beach" rights, do not tie or group your tents together. Good common sense will always be your best rule of thumb.

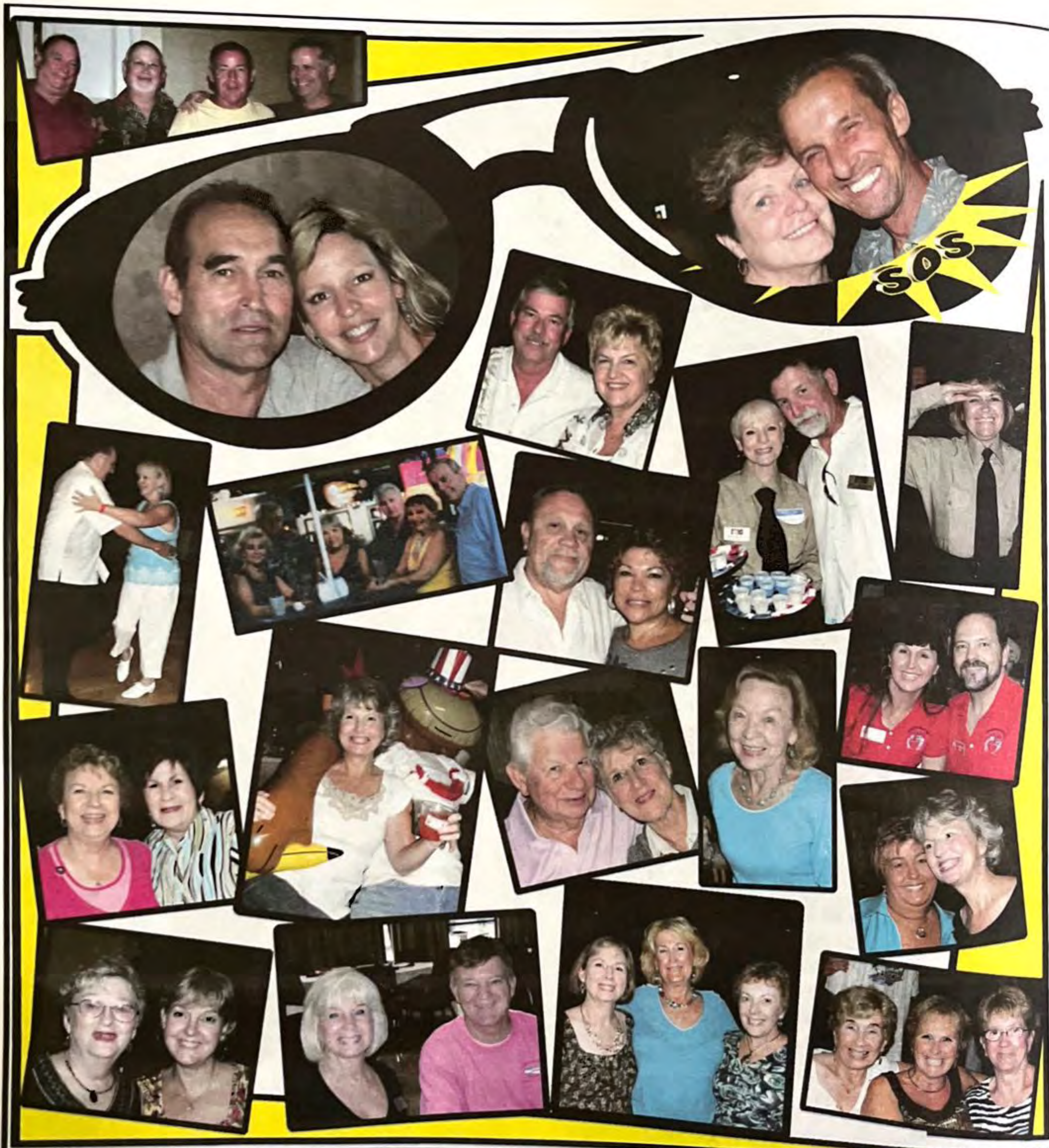

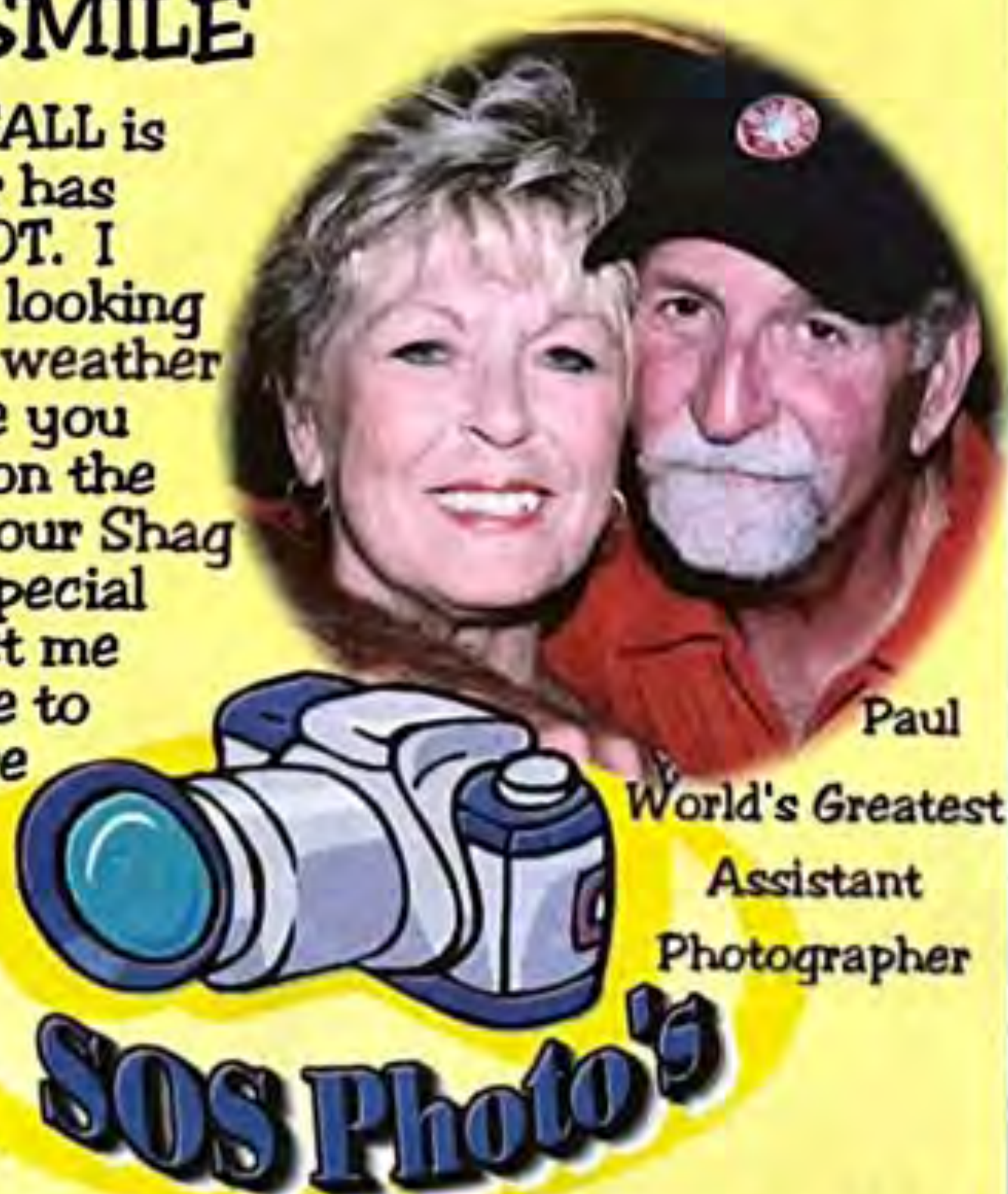

These four ladies have always been in the shadows of their spouses, but always there, always supporting, and serving in any way needed to further the efforts to improve the ACSC and SOS organizations. The award was unexpected, and surprised the four winners. A well deserved award, indeed.*

## *Ms. Chick Sawyer*

Ms. Chick was born in Newberry, SC, and was purported to be of high society. According to Dr. Phil, he married up in class. They met at a dance in Newberry in 1951. They did not see each other again until five years later in Columbia. It was just a chance meeting; however Ms. Chick must have created some spark and interest into Phil. They married a year later in 1957, and had two children, a daughter and son.

In 1979, a beach club named Wits End opened up in Columbia. This was the root of the Columbia Shag Club beginning. Phil and Chick were there for the resurrection of the dance and the music that was played. It was there that they became members of the club and began their career of becoming pioneers in the shag world. When Phil became president of the Columbia Shag Club, Ms. Chick was there, assisting any way needed, helping to teach dance lessons to new shag enthusiasts in the Columbia club, or in new clubs. There were endless miles of trips to other towns and cities to help other clubs start up, and teaching the dance. Ms. Chick helped Phil to establish Greenwood, Hilton Head, and CSRA.

In 1984, as the Association of Carolina Shag Clubs were being formed, there was Ms. Chick doing her thing helping and assisting anyone and everyone who needed to learn the steps or know something about organization and shag dancing. Later when Phil became president, she was the first lady of shag, always at his side, always helping him with the daily duties.

Ms. Chick is one of the charter hostess of Our Time, a member of Living Legends, Central South Carolina Wall of Fame, and continues to assist her husband in his efforts to write a book on the true and factual history of the shag dance.

Ms. Chick's greatest feat was taking Phil out shagging for fifty five consecutive nights, to celebrate their fifty fifth birthday. The record ended at fifty seven nights in a row. She is an Icon in every respect.

## *Peggy Whisenant*

Peggy Whisenant, an Icon in every measure of the description of the award. As a co-founder of the Rock Hill Shag Club, Peggy was the recording secretary of those early meetings, and prepared the minutes during this early establishment period. She hosted and directed the social activities for our club, as well as the fledgling new world of shag. This was a new beginning for shag, and shag clubs began to evolve around our area and throughout the state. She was an organizer, supporter, and worker when it came to advancing the position of shag in our club and around the state. There was not a job that she wouldn't do. She was supportive in every way possible to those that did occupy the elected positions. She was never an elected officer of our shag club, but she has fulfilled all of the requirements and facets of every position within our club, in one way or another. She was the chief assistant to all positions. She served the club, however and wherever she saw the need. She was the heartbeat of the Rock Hill Shag club for many years, and is still highly respected and loved by her club members. She continues to support and work within the club today. The old adage, "behind a good man is a good woman" applies here. Peggy was widely known for her work and support of the shag dance, throughout the shag community.

Peggy was a personality of sorts, and truly "one of a kind" in her early years. She performed her antics for the Rock Hill Club at all of our events and shag nights. Her reputation was known far and wide as being the most uninhibited person in the shag world. Thus, she earned the reputation and title of Ms. Rock Hill Welch (the local version of Raquel Welch, the Hollywood Siren) from Dr. Chris Beachley, a deejay extraordinaire and owner of the Wax Museum in Charlotte, NC. Peggy performed at many parties for other shag clubs, and wore many costumes to celebrate whatever party theme was being promoted, and birthdays of many shag deejays and shag celebrities, such as John Hook, Chris Beachley, Shad Alberty, and too many others to mention. She performed in Charleston, Atlanta, Charlotte, Greenville and Rock Hill parties.

Peggy was always our poster girl when the Association of Carolina Shag Clubs took several cruises in the early years of the ACSC. The ACSC also became another group that she served in the same capacity as she did the Rock Hill Shag Club. Her title, Ms. "Don't Miss the Boat" convinced one hundred fifty shaggers to board a ship for the first ever shag cruise of the ACSC.

I could go on and on promoting Peggy's attributes, and her service to the shag community. Many of you already know that she is a big supporter of all functions of ACSC and SOS. She is always in the background working, assisting, helping, and supporting these efforts. She flies under the radar. She doesn't expect thank yous or special honors, but she deserves any and all that she receives. Peggy is truly an Icon to the Rock Hill Shag Club, The ACSC, and SOS.

## *Carolyn Phifer*

Carolyn Phifer has been on the shag scene for 30+ yrs. I have personally known her for longer than that. Her mild mannerism and ability to think through situations and conclude with solid positive solutions have always been two of her finest attributes.

In the 1980's, Carolyn and her husband, Hector took shag lessons in Charlotte, NC from Shad Alberty. It was after this that Carolyn & Hector began competing and later taught shag lessons. They won several of the competitions. Carolyn, being an English teacher by profession, not only expressed the importance to her students to excel in their education, but also shared with them the importance of expanding their social lives in a good wholesome direction...that direction being dancing the shag. Many people have come into shagging as a direct result of Carolyn's influence. Her love of the dance as well as the music has always been evident.

In 1995 Carolyn was elected President of Sandhills Shag Club. She served two consecutive one year terms and was elected again in 2000 to serve yet another term of office as President. It was during her Presidency that Sandhills Shag Club produced a line dance team competing at NMB during Fall SOS.

Other accomplishments as a founding member of Sandhills Shag Club include serving on the Float Committee, the Nominations Committee, Yard Sale Committee, Hamlet Christmas Parade, Seaboard Festival Booth, six Cancer Fundraisers, SSC Club Bylaws Committee, selling of Raffle Tickets for SOS, soliciting for Silent Auction/Door Prizes for our Annual Boogie & Bogey in the Pines parties, Rockingham Downtown Festival Booth, Telephone Committee, instrumental in designing club shirts, hats, bags, etc., Benevolence Committee, and delivery of Christmas Cheer items to needy families. Carolyn has always been a strong supporter of Jr. Shaggers with her time and finances. Carolyn chaired the 10th Annual Boogie & Bogey in the Pines during her presidency in 2000.

Carolyn has attended all the SOS Workshops, Mid-Winter weekends, and many Jr. Shagger's SOS events in July each year with the exception of one workshop when her sister passed away due to cancer. For years, she worked alongside Hector, putting together a yearly Appreciation Cookout for the Enhancement Committee (Fun Sunday/Fun Monday), ACSC, and SOS board members, plus spouses and other guests. We're talking about sixty people. The last thing Carolyn did for the Enhancement Committee, ACSC board, and SOS board was to have Craig Woolard Band to her home to practice with Archie Bell and the Drells for Fun Monday's Fall Migration. Again, she prepared a meal for approximately fifty people. This is dedication above and beyond.

Carolyn has worked tirelessly out of her motivation to serve whenever she was called upon. Numerous times she stood behind her husband observing the happenings and creating new ideas for the future of all shaggers everywhere. Her ideas became realities and when put into action, successful results.

Carolyn has the shoulder you can cry on, the patience for your troubles and love of a true friend for each of us. She stands ready wherever and whenever the need presents itself. She is a rock, never thinking of herself. She always has YOU in mind.

Honestly, Carolyn Phifer earned her "Icon Award" many years ago. She has truly been the "Wind beneath of wings" for the perseverance of the shag and all its glory! God Bless Carolyn Phifer.

## *Marie Taylor*

When Marie Taylor was a freshman in high school, she saw "the shag" at a sock hop and from that day forward, a love affair began that has lasted all the way through, during, and in the course of her adult years. Marie would go to the "Sands" in Charleston with a friend. He would go his way, she would go another and they would meet up to go home, thus establishing her love for the dance. Marie met her future husband, Larry Taylor at Newberry College and they married. As the children grew, Larry and Marie were able to have "adult fun or adult playtime".

Columbia Shag Club was formed in 1981 and Marie and Larry joined the Club in 1982, at which time she became an active member serving on various committees. How could she know in those early years that such a passion could lead to many long-lasting, rewarding and fun friendships? How could she know that a dance could take her to faraway places such as Hawaii and other shag destinations?

When Phil Sawyer was president of Columbia Shag Club, Marie was his vice-president, or as Phil lovingly referred to her, "heartbeat" (only a "heartbeat" away from the presidency). Marie served under Phil as his "heartbeat" twice. When Burns Harris became president, she served again as vice-president. In later years when Mike Robinson became president in 2007, Marie again stepped up to the plate and served as vice president until 2008 when she finally decided she had enough practice and became president. She served as president of the Columbia Shag Club until 2010.

In the eighties, the foundation of the ACSC was formed. In 1988, the ACSC acquired SOS. Larry was the first chairman of the SOS Board formed in 1989 and served as Board Chairman until 1992. In those early years, there were many long and productive meetings laying the foundation of SOS as we know it today. Marie was a strong supporter of Larry's position, so much so that she served on various SOS committees during his tenure and subsequent years.

The CSRA Shag Club was formed in 1985. Larry and Marie were instrumental in helping form the club. Because of their hard work, CSRA awarded them plaques designating them charter members of CSRA.

Marie and Larry were inducted into the Central Shaggers Wall of Fame in 1993. This is located in Columbia, South Carolina and honors shaggers who have been involved in the dance and music. Marie served as secretary of this organization.

In 1999, Marie was inducted into the Beach Shaggers Hall of Fame in North Myrtle Beach. The Hall of Fame honors shaggers from all over the Southeast for their dedication and preservation of the dance.

Fat Harold's Beach Club honors dedicated dancers of the shag into Living Legends every spring in North Myrtle Beach. Marie received this honor in 2001.

The National Living Legends will be held in Virginia Beach, Virginia in November 2010, which Marie will be inducted as a National Living Legend.

Marie Taylor has demonstrated her love for the dance and the music by her actions. It is fitting for Marie to receive this honor.

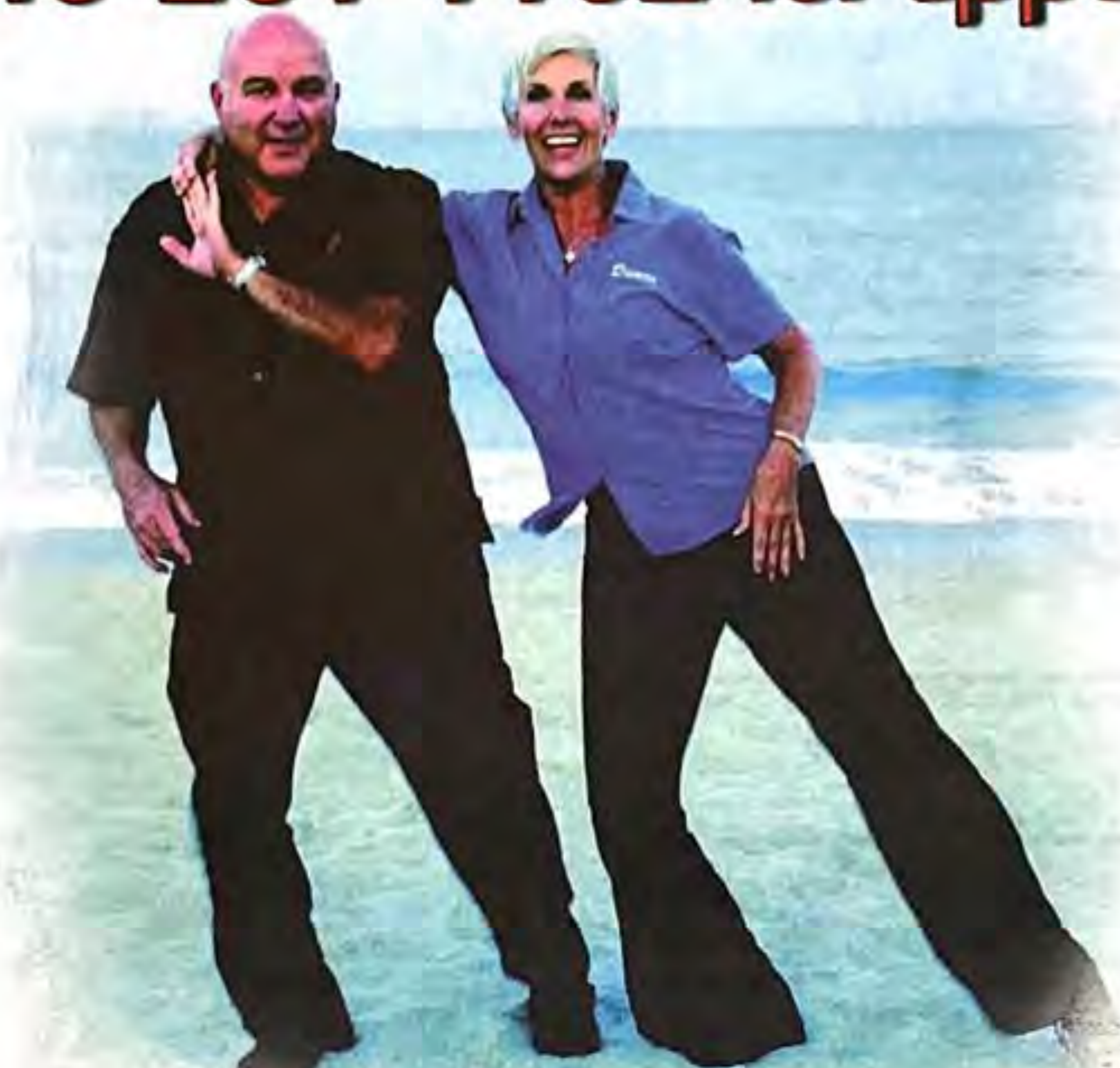

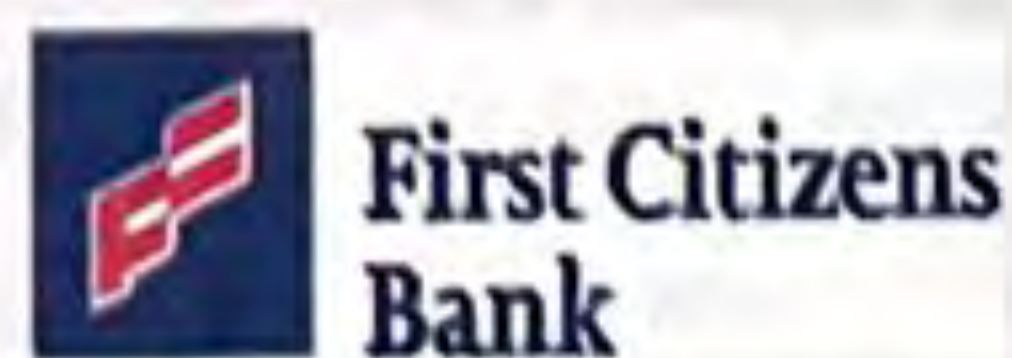

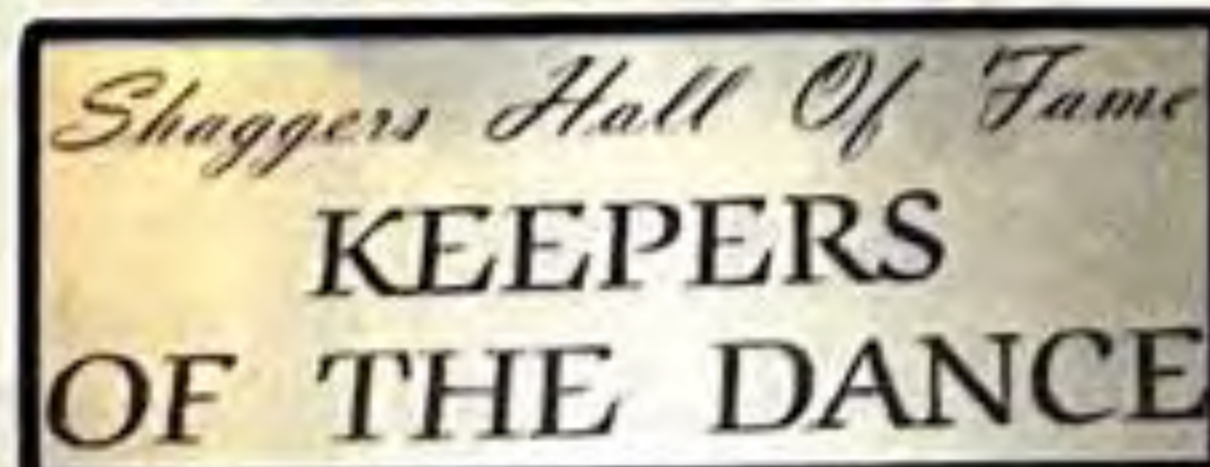

Now, I rest in Ginny's closet along with my many other retired friends, Motown, Capitol, Imperial, King, Federal, Atlantic, Chess just to name a few.

My story does not end just yet. Last night Ginny brought all of us downstairs and we had our own personal vinyl party. Holding me in her hand, she told me I was purchased one Saturday morning from the Greensboro Record Center for \$1.00. She assured me that I was her most favorite before she laid me on the turntable for a nostalgic spin. I know she will never forget me because I play my tune for her many times a day. I am now her ringtone in her cellphone!

# My Music Or Yours

Yes, oh yes! It's SOS. There's plenty of fun, and plenty of music. Don't know what to buy? Don't let it bug you. You Bug Me Baby is here for the Fall Migration. This new compilation from KHP Records is headlined by the title track, You Bug Me Baby, by Rhonda McDaniel and Mike Taylor. The Carolina Beach Music Awards' Female Vocalist of the Year joins one of the lead vocalists and songwriter from The Holiday Band to give us a killer version of the song previously recorded by Francine Reed and Delbert McClinton. It is no wonder that they used this song as the title track. Rhonda and Mike really belt it out. The Magnificents Band join in on the compilation with a great rendition of the classic Archie Bell & The Drells' You Never Know What's On A Woman's Mind. Archie's hard-to-find song was recorded as the B-side of a single in May 1973 on the Glades label, shortly after the group was dropped by Atlantic. The Magnificents, located out of Burlington, North Carolina, who was chosen the 2007 CBMA Favorite New Artists of the Year, were originally formed in the late sixties and brought back to life in 2006. Andre' Lee has a strong hit on the charts now, One Night Stand. The Chicago native, who now resides in Jackson, Mississippi, comes on strong with the smoothie, Love Will Never Change. Andre' Lee, whose given name is Andrew Lee Caples, is a well known songwriter and producer in the industry. The Holiday Band joins the compilation with another hit-in-the-making, Your Sweet Love. The number was written by Holiday's Mike Taylor and Duane Neese. Duane handles the lead vocals. Vickie Skinner has a song on the album. She really does a great job with Who Do You Love? It is a remake of the early 60's hit by The Sapphires. The Castaways are with us with a number for the album. Lead singer Karen Clayton does a wonderful job with the Lari White song, Next To Love. The Emperor is

back! Paul Craver is smooth. And he is really smooth this time as he gives us his take on The Four Aces' classic, Love Is A Many Splendored Thing. Paul has made quite a name for himself over the past few years as a solo artist coming from a long-time stint as lead vocalist for The Men Of Distinction. William Bell's music has always been a favorite. Easy Coming Out (Hard Goin In) is an all time Beach & Shag favorite and his duet with the late Fayetteville, North Carolina native Judy Clay, Private Number, has always been a crowd pleaser. William has a new song out, and it is a part of You Bug Me Baby. The number is titled Treat Her Right (Like A Lady). Don't confuse the title with Treat Her Like A Lady by Cornelius Brothers & Sister Rose. This is a brand new song penned by William also appears on his new release, New Lease On Life from his own



Wilbe Records in Atlanta. The Entertainers celebrated their 30th anniversary at the turn of the new decade by releasing the group's new album, The Entertainers... The Inside Story. One of the key songs from the release is the medley, Stubborn Kind Of Fellow/It's Got To Be Mellow. The song caught on and has been played frequently in a number of clubs. The song has been remastered and is now a part of You Bug Me Baby. After thirty years Earl Dawkins and the boys still have it. Salisbury, North Carolina newcomers, Atlantic Groove, led by Brian Hatley, makes their debut with I Got To Change. The song was originally recorded by Tommy Castro. Another Tommy Castro song was also chosen for the album. Gary Brown is a perfect vocalist Sho-Nuf. Gary also has another song that is a part of the album. This one is Sofa Circuit, originally put out by The Fabulous Thunderbirds. Hip Pocket, one of the younger bands in the Beach Music circuit, join in with their take on Christ Kenner's Packin' Up. Surely, you are familiar with the name, Glenn Tippet. He is the keyboardist for The Coastline Band, and also plays sax. One of the hottest songs going these days is Why Don't We Just Dance by Josh Turner. Check out Glenn's take on the song. The album also includes a hot song from Willie Clayton, Some Kind Of Wonderful. You Bug Me Baby can be order on line at khpmusic.com.

You may remember several years ago when

58 West out of Danville, Virginia released their debut album, Get My Fanny Back To The Beach. Band guitarist Rickie Fox and keyboardist Scott Frazier have teamed to release their own album, Fox And Frazier...Borrowed Time. You may have heard a few of the songs off the album. Forevermore by Rickie and Scott appeared on the album Come On & Dance With Me. I Thought It Was You by Rickie and Scott was a part of Take A Little Ocean Drive. Also, a song called Fantasy by Rickie was sent out to deejays for the Spring Safari this past April by beachmusic45.com. Though most of the songs are original, the two join together for Al Green's Let's Stay Together. Other original song on the album includes, the title track, Borrowed Time, Retro Dreams and You Do It For Me. Born in a musical family, Rickie Fox is multi-instrumentally talented. Following high school, he pretty much went full time music. On a dare from his wife, Sharon, he enrolled in LPN at the age of 34, becoming a Registered Nurse. He later received a call into the ministry and attended Liberty Bible Institute at Liberty University for two years, spending the next six years as a full time minister. In 2005, Rickie returned to nursing and his love of playing and recording music. Scott Frazier began playing music at the age of twelve. When he was fourteen, he traveled with the contemporary Christian group, Higher Ground. Scott began playing the keyboards in 1973 with a group called The Believers. From there, he began playing with The Day Spring Trio. In 1979 the group recorded their first album. Scott later became a founding member of The After Hours Band. He connected with Rickie Fox in the group, Paradise. He went on to become the keyboardist for 58 West. Rickie and Scott have maintained a strong friendship over the years. Both are accomplished musicians and writers and continue to challenge one another, bringing



out the best of their potential. Fox And Frazier... Borrowed Time is available for sale now.

Tobacco Road Records has a new release out, Come On & Dance With Me? The compilation debuted at the tail end of the recent Spring Safari of SOS. Though new on the roads of Beach Music, Tobacco Road really shines with this new release. Two songs from the album have already hit the beachmusic45 chart, Shagland by Bubba D. Liverence and That Boy Can Shag by The Castaways. Though Bubba D. Liverence has made a name for himself over the past year with a number of hits, his talents as a singer and a songwriter really shine with Shagland. That



Boy Can Shag starts out with a tribute to Billy Scott, and that I really like for a dear friend that has played a major part of our music since the sixties. I look for this number by The Castaways to continue to climb the charts. There are more songs that are bound to hit the charts, but we will just have to wait and see what catches on. Among them is Too Much Booty Shakin' (Up In Here) by Jonathan Burton. The Carolina Breakers come on strong with their rendition of The Clovers' Don't Play That Song (You Lied). Tommy Black & Blooz give a true danceable version to Sonny Turner & The Platters' I Love You 1,000 Times. This classic remake features Keith Pollard up front. Dancin' Man Blues by Sweet T featuring Rebecca Lapping has been around for quite some time, however their inclusion into Come On & Dance With Me is really the first time it has been available to our market. You do not want to overlook this song. Pat Christie and Terri Gore join forces to provide us with their take on the famed Diana Ross/Lionel Ritchie duet, Endless Love. Other notables on the Come On & Dance With Me compilation include Forevermore by Rickie Fox and Scott Frazier, and a strong number, Ain't That Good Enough, by Rachel Tripp. Rachel, as you know, is the daughter of Freddy Tripp, keyboardist, horn player and vocalist with The Fantastic Shakers. The Night Riders perform the title track of this Tobacco Road Records release, Come One & Dance With Me. Band member Ray Atwater and his wife, Doris, penned the

song. The Night Riders roots go back to 1965, when the band was formed. The Saints of Soul join in on the compilation with You And I, and the Cross-Cut Band provides us with Country Girl. Come On & Dance With Me should be relatively easy to find. Judy's House of Oldies has it on the shelf or you find it on the World Wide Web site of Southern Soul Music, [www.buybeachmusic.com](http://www.buybeachmusic.com).

The members of The Carolina Breakers, more or less, have enough material to release a greatest hits CD. And that, per se, is exactly what they did, with a number of new songs to boot, with the album, Keys To My Heart. The group started as a trio with Gary Lowder of The Gary Lowder Band, Jerry Shooter of Gold Rush and Roger Taylor, who wrote the music behind the award winning Shadow Shaggin', written by Tommy Black and recorded by Tommy Black & Blooz. The Breakers, based out of North Myrtle Beach, has added Keith Pollard, formerly with Tommy Black and Blooz, and Dale Phillips, formerly with Gold Rush, to round out the band. The album is comprised of several previously recorded songs from Jerry Shooter & Gold Rush, the mega-hit Boardwalk Angel, Everybody Needs Love and Summer Girl. Jerry's solo number, Without You Girl, is also on the album. Gary Lowder's Maybe This Time, previously recorded on a Gary Lowder Band release, is a part of the collection, and so is Keith Pollard's I Love You 1000 Times, previously recorded by Tommy Black & Blooz and released on a compilation. The Carolina Breakers' Don't Play That Song (You Lied), that appeared on another compilation, is also included in this new Carolina Breakers album. Of the new material on the release, an original, Just Wanna Go Back, penned by Keith Pollard and recorded by the group, is included. Another new song by The Carolina Breakers is the title track, Keys To My Heart, which is an original tune penned by the band. Also, as a part of the album, comes The Breakers' take on Sho Nuff. And Gary Lowder gives us his rendition of The Neville Brothers' Old Habits Die Hard, as well as Keith Pollard rounding out the collection with his take on a Lou Rawls classic. Of course, there are bound to be some surprises included on the album before it is released in time for the Fall Migration. The Carolina Breakers' Keys To My Heart is unlocked and ready for the taking.



Looking for a party with live music? Check out the new CD, Jim Quick & Coastline... Live At HOTO's. The album was recorded at the group's appearance this past April at Harold's On The Ocean, more commonly known as HOTO's, in Cherry Grove.

The album was produced and mixed by band member Casey Meyer, who also co-engineered the project with Ken Holland and Eddie Cogle. Party with the band as they belt out the hits such as It's Gonna Rain, Turn Myself In, Sweat, Mississippi Mud, She Poured It On and Turn Me Over. Jim and the boys switch hats on this live performance and bring on King Tyrone & The Graveyard Ramblers with their mega-hit, Mama's Drinkin' Liquor Again and the group's latest, I Didn't Buy This Beer (But I'm Paying The Price). And there is lots more. Jim Quick & Coastline... Live At HOTO's...it's one you just gotta have!

### Thank You For Caring

The Hall of Fame Foundation deeply appreciates your interest. Established in 1991 with cash donations from a few people, were added to proceeds from a Shaggers' Hall of Fame Weekend in Greenville, SC. The accumulated fund was made available to provide financial aid to people of all ages and circumstances. The grants are based only on financial need, regardless of race, religion, dance ability or any other criteria.

The Hall of Fame Foundation is not affiliated with the Shagger's Hall of Fame. The Foundation is chartered as an eleemosynary organization in South Carolina with IRS 501 (3)(c) tax-exempt status. Traditionally, Foundation contributions come from shaggers and shag-affiliated organizations.

The Foundation is managed by a thirteen (13) member Board of Directors, all volunteers. Vacancies are filled by the Board. Only persons who have extensive and proven records of significant community service are selected to serve.

All contributions to the Foundation are deposited in unrestricted, interest-bearing investment and checking accounts. Intricate rules and procedures are in place to insure the integrity of all donations. Typically, annual administrative and operating expense/income ratio is three to five percent. This is extremely low. The only operating expenses paid from contributions are postage, supplies, telephone tolls, and the annual financial reports audited by a Certified Public Accountant. Limited travel expenses are reimbursed to Board members. The Foundation has no office space and no salaried positions.

### Long-Range Goal

The long-range plan for the Hall of Fame Foundation is to acquire a principle sufficient to remain in perpetual trust. Interest from the trust will provide for grants to applicants, approved by the Board of Directors. The principle will remain intact in perpetuity.

# Making It Easier for Kids to Shag...

The Ellen Taylor Foundation for Junior Shaggers ("ETFJS") is now in its 3rd year of operation but remains somewhat unknown in the shag community as evidenced by the limited number of year-to-date applications for assistance. As you enjoy Fall SOS the Board of the ETFJS would like for you to consider the following questions:

- Ever hear of a kid who is interested in attending a shag event but cannot afford the hotel, travel, or tickets?....or maybe a family is having to choose between attending one junior shag event rather than attending both events that their kid is interested in?
- Know of a ACSC shag club or other group that might do a junior workshop but doesn't have the funds to implement?
- Have a kid or grandkid that shags who seems to outgrow their dancing shoes every few months?

If you answered "yes" to any of the above questions, then the ETFJS can help! The ETFJS has a mandate to remove financial barriers that may prevent kids from learning and participating in shag dance events. The assistance provided by the ETFJS is done anonymously and is "need blind" – in other words it is not exclusively for families who are undergoing financial hardship – it is intended to be for any junior shagger who is in need of financial assistance to participate in a shag event. In the past three years here is a sample of the ways that the ETFJS has helped.

- Providing food, lodging, and gas money for several juniors to attend Junior SOS and Grand Nationals
- Giving out literally hundreds of free shoes due to the generosity of our donors who have given to our shoe exchange program
- Reimbursing mileage for groups of juniors to travel to a shag event
- Funding Junior Shag workshops in various cities

# Beach Music and the Carolinas

Harry Turner, Vice President

When one thinks of the Carolinas so often it is about the coast or the mountains, ACC basketball, South Carolina and Clemson, Research Triangle Park, the booming upstate of South Carolina, clogging, shagging and the like. All of these things are positive and unique to the Carolinas. But there is one other Carolina thing and maybe the most positive and influential of all—good ole beach music.

Beach music was not invented in the Carolinas but without the Carolina influence much of it would not be heard anywhere today. It consists of many national and international hits and has under its umbrella rhythm & blues (R&B), Motown, soul, doo-wop, New Orleans R&B, the blues, good-time rock and other R&B styles. It is a music type often affiliated with the shag dance, but is broader than the standard 120 beats per minute for shagging. It includes many up-tempo as well as slow tunes and some that are just for listening. Many of the original beach music legends had few songs that were shagged to. An example is Jerry Butler who didn't really dent the shag world until he released a disco song later in his career, "I'm Just Thinking About Cooling Out." Many Carolinians were never moved by music styles that became popular worldwide. When the Beatles-led British Invasion occurred in the 1960's Carolinians for the most part stayed with the familiar R&B styles. Part of the reason was that British music was bubblegummish and the bulk of it was not dance music. We Carolinians loved music for dancing or certainly to move to.

Superstars in what later became known as beach music were in addition to Butler such artists as the Drifters, the Clovers, the Chairmen of the Board, Jackie Wilson, Billy Stewart, Marvin Gaye, the Temptations, the Tams, Maurice Williams & the Zodiacs, the Four Tops, Jr. Walker & the All-Stars, Archie Bell and the Drells, the Swinging Medallions, the Miracles, Chuck Jackson, Little Anthony & the Imperials, Sam Cooke, Bill Deal & the Rondells, etc. Additionally there were some very popular regional bands like the Embers, the Catalinas, the Georgia Prophets, the Monzas, Harry's Band, Harry Deal & the Galaxies, the Spontanes and others. As national recording companies quit recording our favorite artists, the regional bands stepped forward in the 1970's and 1980's and recorded songs in the R&B style that became very popular regional hits. Examples were "I Love Beach Music" by the Embers, "Summertime's Calling Me" by the Catalinas, "Myrtle Beach Days" by the Fantastic Shakers, "Ocean Boulevard" by the Band of Oz and even several by the transplanted to the Carolinas Chairmen of the Board. These and other hits were mainly about the Grand Strand and its partying lifestyle, shagging, Carolina Girls, drinking beer, surf and sand, but always with an R&B feel.

In the 1970's shag clubs began springing up throughout the Carolinas and the dance began a solid comeback from its early days. SOS (Society of Stranders) began a twice-annual migration of shaggers to North Myrtle Beach three decades ago. In the revival and SOS's beginnings the DJ's played almost all beach music, but over time disco, country and western, big band smoothies, rock, rap, Latin and other music styles have become part of the shag world. Included are many great shagging songs, but they are not beach music songs. Indeed if anything these songs should be called shag songs. Some in the industry already refer to them by that term.

Many Carolinians feel that beach music itself is such an important contribution to the world and so strongly represents the best of the

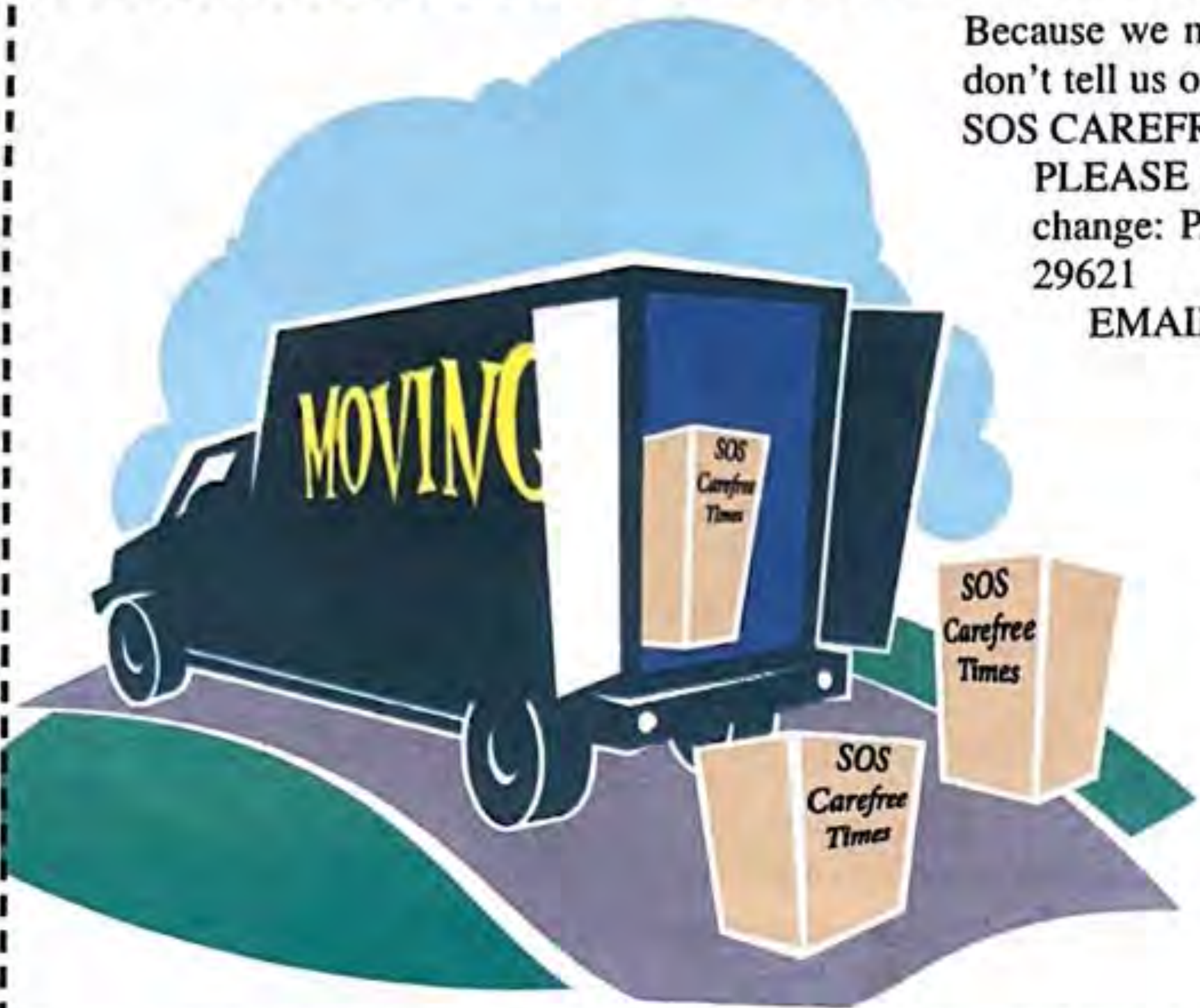
Carolinas that it must be remembered, preserved, and promoted. Certainly, young people must be reached educationally and in a fun manner. If too many people have as their definition of beach music, "It is whatever you can shag to" and these other styles are being played and shagged to, then beach music will fade into obscurity.

That is why several concerned beach music lovers have joined forces at Coastal Carolina University to form the Beach Music Hall of Fame to be housed on its campus. It ties beach music to the academic world, thus guaranteeing its continuity and giving it a newfound level of respect as an art form. It will honor artists, songs, songwriters, musicians, venues, radio personalities, DJ's, promoters, recording executives and others in the background in the industry. After much diligent study, consideration and discussion our board of directors have selected the first eight artist inductees. Watch for the announcement sometime in September or October. As we will be inducting chronologically, the members of our first class had to have their first hits from 1955 back.

The shag will always be remembered along with beach music and we will have shaggers at our functions. But the Shaggers Hall of Fame is housed at the Ocean Drive Beach and Golf Resort in North Myrtle Beach and is a separate entity entirely. Many who are at the SOS Fall Migration remember and love the original style beach music and it is our desire that they and others be aware of this exciting concept, which will guarantee that the music that they and we love will always be with us.

From board members of the Beach Music Hall of Fame at Coastal Carolina University, here is wishing that this year's Fall Migration be your most enjoyable ever. While here we invite you to listen to 94.9 The Surf each Tuesday and Thursday at 12:30 PM during The Ted Bell Show as The Beach Music Hall of Fame presents "The Roots of Beach Music."

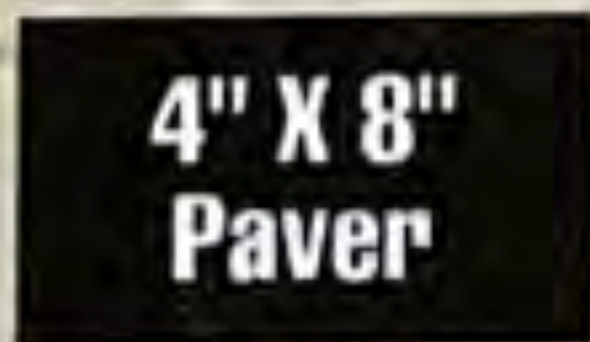
