We all get so excited to see Rock Hill Stowe's shaggers on the water tower, then on to Rock Hill Street to see the crowd at Duck's, Fat Harold's, Pirates Cove, Spanish Galleon, HOTO's, and OD Arcade. It is hard to believe that North Myrtle Beach is celebrating 50 fabulous years. The home of the "Carolina Shag". In the Collector's Edition of "North Myrtle Beach Celebrates 50 Fabulous Years", Mayor Marilyn Hester states that on May 7, 1968, the State of South Carolina issued a charter formally recognizing the incorporation of the city of North Myrtle Beach. Hugo, produced 12 ft. high walls of water and sadly the protective dunes were mostly washed away. Hugo destroyed:

piers, caused 27 fatalities, left 100,000 homeless and \$10 billion in damages. Mathew makes a hit on North Myrtle when the Atlantic Ocean reached high tide, flooding streets, destroying piers and forcing hundreds into shelters. Mother nature has certainly wreaked havoc on your shaggers' paradise, but North Myrtle Beach always has come back stronger and better than before. As of this date, we have never had to cancel an SOS due to bad weather.

We all have our favorite businesses and restaurants that we patronize in North Myrtle Beach. Let's share a little history: Boulineau's opened its first store in 1948 and has 85,000 sq. ft of shopping today. In 1978 the Shoe Center opened its doors and will be celebrating 40 years of service. From the youngest participant to the oldest "living" member, it's rather apparent that music and "the dance" that we all enjoy, can provide a place where all generations can meet on common ground such as a dance floor, and brush aside the differences that age seems to press upon us.

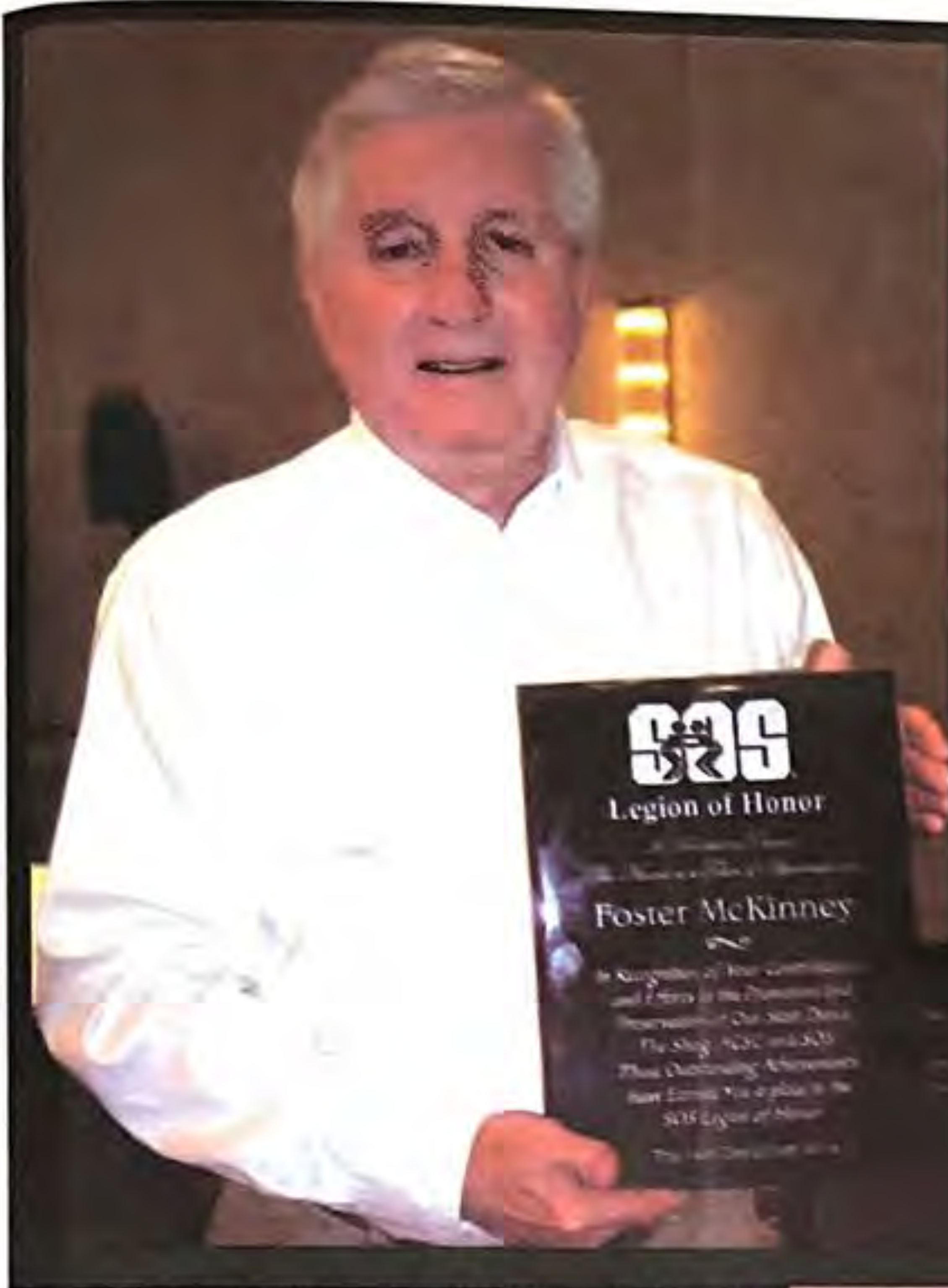

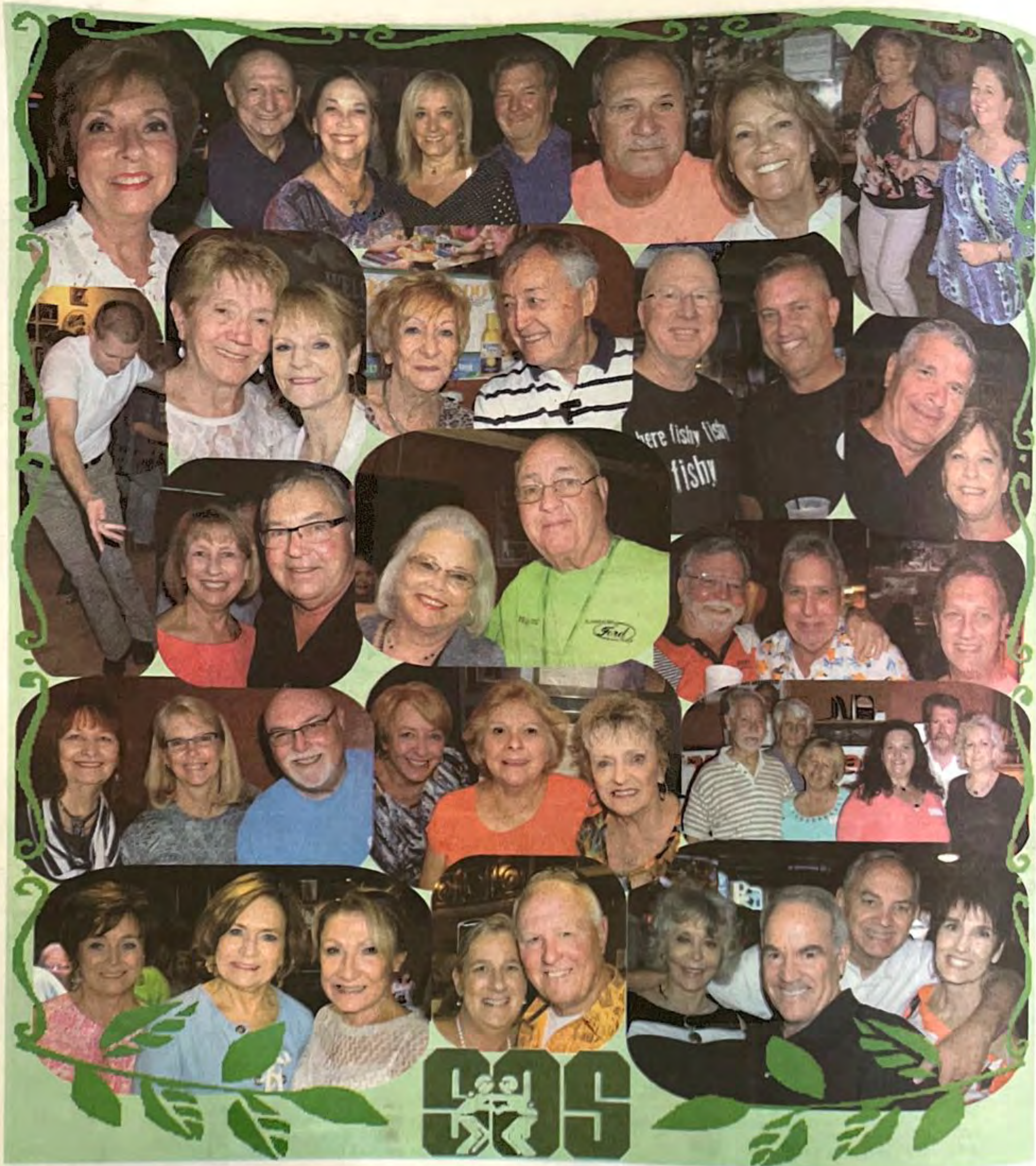

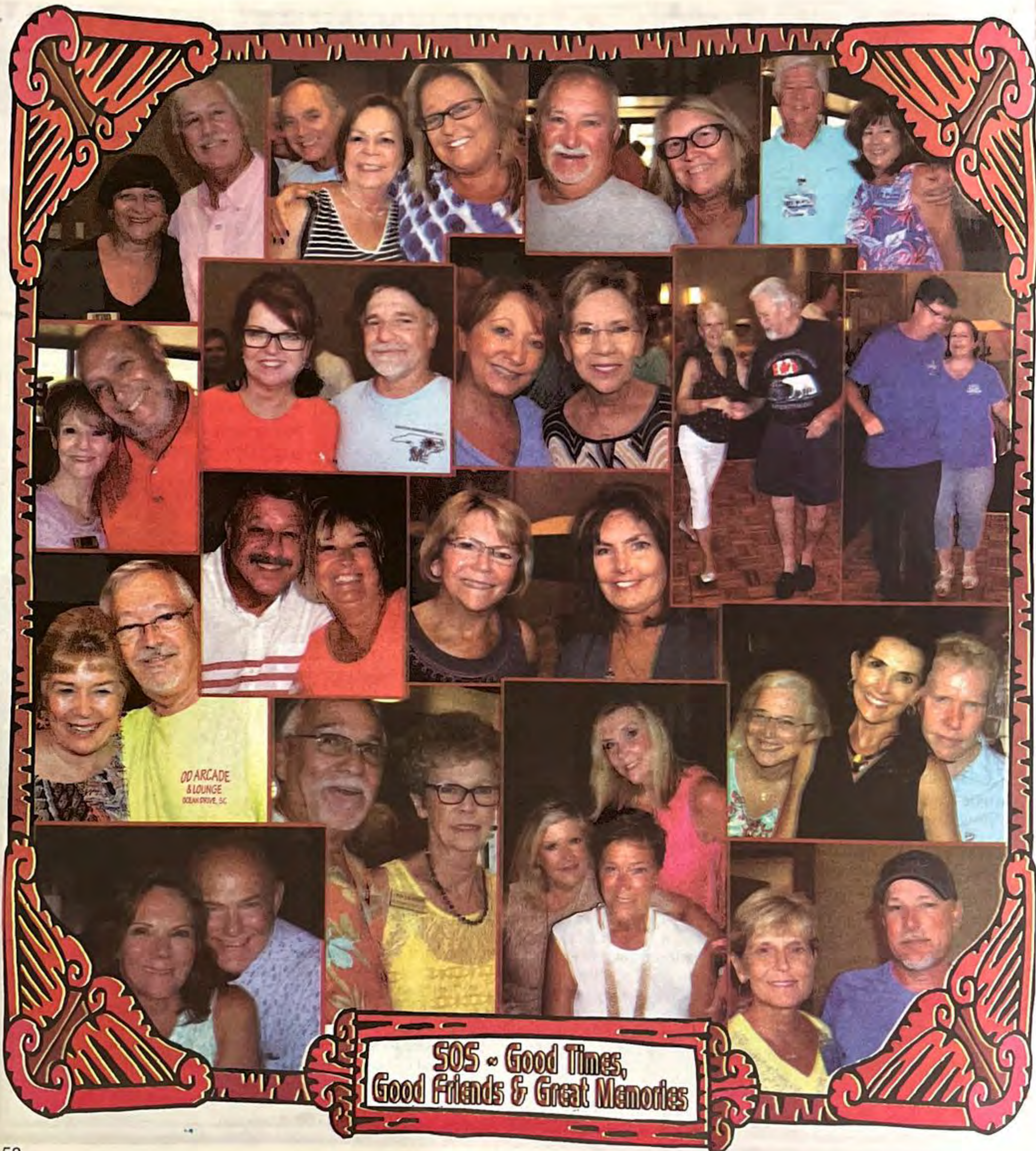

On August 20th, 2018 94.9 TheSurf celebrated it's 20th Birthday having started the "Beach, Boogie, and Blues" format August 19th, 1998. The very first song played was the well known classic "Summertime" by Billy Stewart. From that moment on it was a done deal! The station grew in popularity by leaps and bounds aided by some of the best radio DJ's around including Fessa John Hook, The Legendary Billy Smith, and the many talents of Ted Bell and Ray Scott.

By this time 949TheSurf.com had come into existence and was gaining hundreds of listeners all across the country. It also became known as the Official Radio Station of SOS.

In December 2010 owner Harvey Graham passed away after a long illness. Shortly afterward the station "went dark" much to the dismay of thousands of listeners, but thankfully returned mid-April of 2011 under the partnership of Harold Worley and Bill Norman of WNMB fame.

In 2011 Jason "The Judge" Justice came on board followed by Stephen "Stevie B" Blackburn. 2016 added Mike Worley (no relation to Harold Worley) and 2017 brought in Jim Morgan. Jason, Mike, and Jim are the current 3 DJ's with "Silent Sam" holding down the nights until the early morning hours.

94.9 has been awarded Station of the Year for 10 years in a row by the Carolina Beach Music Awards. The station has also been host to the 'Mystery Grand Marshal Contest' for 15 years, a contest where the listeners try to guess each year who will be the Grand Marshal of the SOS Spring Safari Parade. This is the longest running radio contest on the Grand Strand and quite possibly in the entire state.

With a listening audience of 2,000,000 plus and growing across the nation The Surf can also boast of having followers in Canada, Japan, Australia, The UK, Afghanistan, and honestly who knows where else.

Beach music is loved around the world and we love The Surf! Happy Birthday and may you have many, many more!!

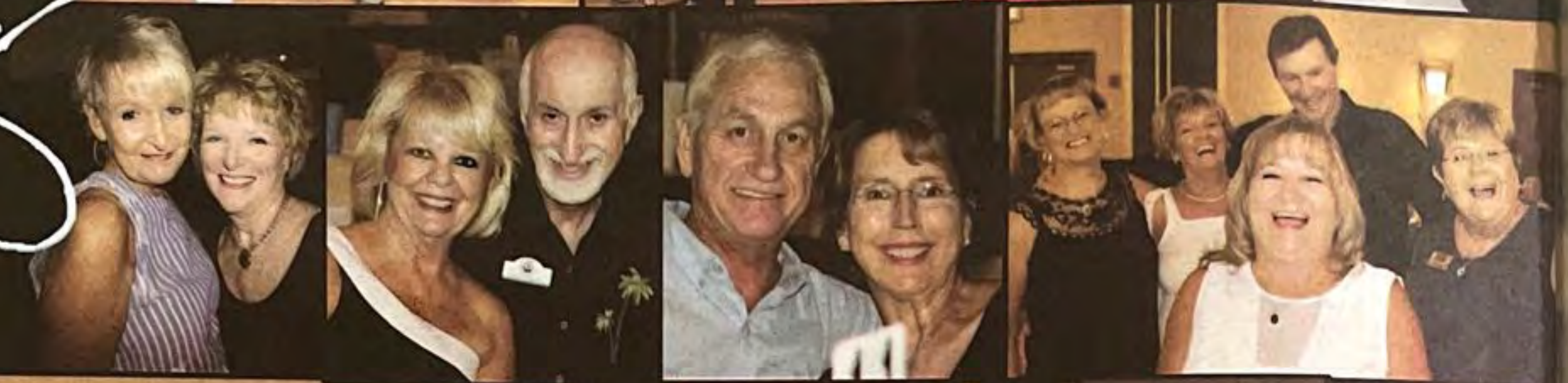

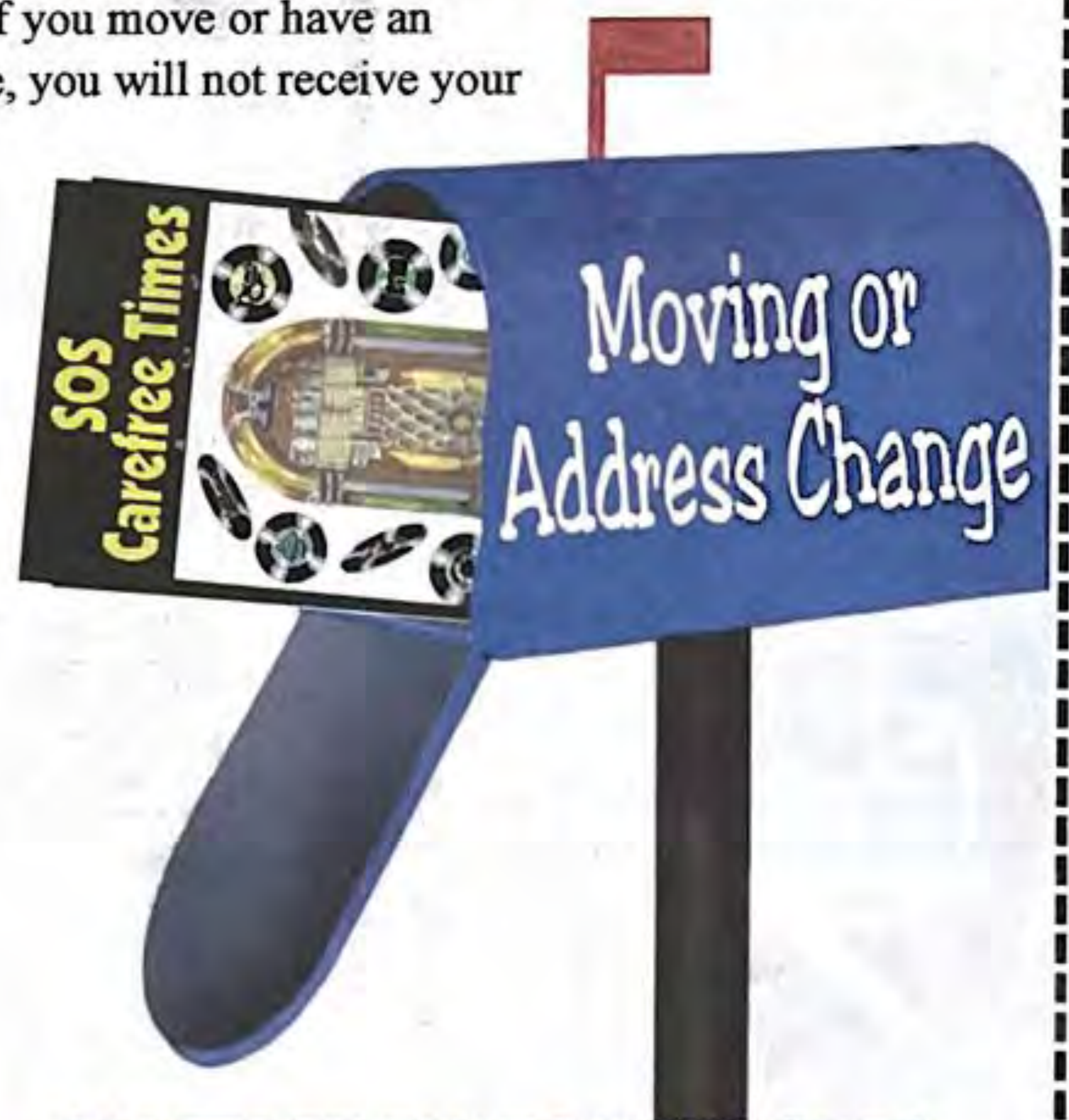

FALL IS FOR FISHING....and maybe a couple of other things.

We get a lot of questions!! And, YES, we are more than just about dance shoes! Our Dance Shoes Program is probably the most well-known program in the Ellen Taylor Foundation for Junior Shaggers (ETFJS). However, our goal is to keep the dance and the music we all love alive by supporting Junior Shaggers who request assistance, whether a beginner dancer anxious to attend their first Junior SOS or an experienced dance team member needing financial support. Or particularly those Juniors in need of their next pair of dance shoes! Approved as a SC-501-(c)-(3) tax deductible organization in 2008, "the Foundation is dedicated to

financial assistance in education, preservation, and promotion of "The Shag" - the state dance of South Carolina, and the "Carolina Shag" - the state dance of North Carolina."

Three programs are designed to assist Junior shag dancers:

The *Financial Assistance Program* provides individual support to Junior Shag related events by subsidizing the family's expense to attend Junior shag related events. Our objective is to perpetuate and preserve shag dance, rhythm and blues beach music, the atmosphere surrounding the shag dance, and to create and maintain an environment conducive to the dance.

The *Dance Shoe Program* maintains an inventory of donated, new and gently danced, dance shoes and distributes them to Junior Shaggers at Junior SOS and other events.

The *Workshop Assistance Program* provides financial support for Junior shag workshops, dances, and events. If your shag club is interested in hosting workshops for Juniors, ETFJS is available to assist.

We are grateful to the membership of the Association of

Carolina Shag Clubs (ACSC) and countless individuals who have graciously donated to ETFJS. In 2017, we were able to assist 87 Juniors, up from 65 in 2016. We are proud to acknowledge the ETFJS has never denied an application for assistance. We have provided assistance to Juniors for National Shag Dance Championship, Junior SOS, USA Grand National Dance Championship, Junior Cyclone, U.S. Open, Junior Shag events, and workshops.

96% of all donations fund Junior Shaggers. ETFJS expenses include costs and fees associated with our website, printing, postage, advertising, and supplies. Our books are always open.

The ETFJS Board of Directors is an all-volunteer Board comprised of Ellen Taylor, Director Emeritus, Kyle Taylor, Executive Director, Foster McKinney, Executive Director, Donna Hosaflook, Director/Fundraising Chairperson, Karen Callahan, Director/Secretary, Garrett Humphries, Director/Workshop Program Chairperson, and Crystal Hummer, Director/Treasurer.
