It's definitely not a song you can dance to, but it's been hanging around beach music for as long as I can remember. Billy's unique style of scat singing and trilling his lips has made him one of a kind. Discovered by Bo Diddley in 1956 he had only a short 15 year career. Tragically he was killed along with three of his band members when his 12 day old Thunderbird plunged into the Neuse River near Smithfield, NC in broad daylight while traveling to a performance in Columbia, SC. He was only 32 years old. He recorded many songs. In addition to SUMMERTIME some of the other favorites in our area are FAT BOY, I DO LOVE YOU, SITTING IN THE PARK, and SECRET LOVE.

Songs like that will never be forgotten...
