



**A.C.S.C. MEETING MINUTES
SOS SPRING SAFARI
NORTH MYRTLE BEACH, SC
SATURDAY, APRIL 29, 2017**

I. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Ken Akin called the Association of Carolina Shag Clubs Spring Safari meeting to order at North Myrtle Beach, SC on Saturday, April 29th at 10:00 a.m. Meeting Agenda was Approved.
