The SOS Tram, provided by Tripps Taxi Service, is a 28 passenger bus service that will travel up and down Ocean Boulevard, offering free shuttle to and from the SOS Beach Clubs. The SOS tram will not wait for anyone for any extended period of time.

The SOS tram will operate on the following dates: Friday and Saturday, September 14 & 15th, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday, September 20th - 22nd, starting @ 8:00pm - 2:00am, on each date.

The tram service will start @ 8:00pm in Cherry Grove, travel to Main, drop off...travel to 27th Ave S, and return to Main St. Each trip should be approximately 20 - 30 minutes duration, for each direction traveled. The Tram will leave Main Street on the hour, during the later hours of operation. The trams are provided by SOS for our membership.

Chick was one of the pioneers of our dance. Chick and guys like him are the guys who went to the beaches in the '40's and '50's and opened them up for all us dancers that came along later. The National Association of Rhythm & Blues Deejays has teamed with KHP Music to release Coast To Coast...The Music Lives On. Dedicated to past president of NARBD, the late Tom Polzin, who spearheaded the Association's previous album, the new release will feature music that will appeal to dancers from all parts of our great nation. From

West Coast Swing to East Coast Swing. From Rop to Shag. From Jitterbug to Fast Dance. This one has it all. Renowned Austin, Texas Soul band, Mingo Fishtrap joins the array of artists with Back It On Up. The release also features Ecko Records recording artist, Donnie Ray with I'm Gonna Try Again, Southern

Soul Shag Mix. At the time of writing this article, the Texarkana, Texas native/Montgomery, Alabama resident has two charted songs on the Carolina Beach Music charts, Who's Rockin' You and I'm Goin' Back. The album also contains Too Far Gone by David Shelley & Blaustone. David often was a featured artist in Government Mule's concerts. From swamp Blues to back porch picking, Lloyd Jones, a native of Portland, Oregon, has forged a 30+ year career as an impassionate singer and fierce guitar player. Just listen to his take on I'll Be Right On Down. Hailing from Kentucky and his family roots imbedded in Bluegrass, Lamont Gillespie grow up listening to the Blues and Rhythm & Blues on Nashville, Tennessee's WLAC radio. He and his 100 Proof Blues Band brings us I Don't Need Another Heartache. The album will feature Donnie Ray's new hot song, I'm Goin' Back. The song already has reached the beachmusic45.com's Smokin' 45 chart and climbing rapidly. Craig Woulard will give his take on Woo. The number is already getting huge play time along the coast. The song should find instant popularity and enter the charts in short order. The album will also have Ms. Jody's popular line dance

song, Ms. Jody's Thing. This dance is growing in popularity. The compilation will also feature songs from Grammy Award winner Gary Brown with I Just Want To Dance With You. Gary is a very well known singer with a rich history. In 2005, his rendition of Is The Magic Still There took top honors for Song of the Year in the annual Carolina Beach Music Awards. The BigTime Party Band has a hot song out called Cherry Groove. The charted song is a part of the Carolina Shag III package. South Brunswick, New Jersey's Wallstreet is back with us with a new song, Something You Got. Hill and Little Joe Blue. While working with Little Joe Blue, he took up guitar, later fronting his own band. Other songs found on this new compilation come from The Out Of Towners Band and Dip Ferrell & The True Tones, as well as *Farewell My Summer Love* by The Craig Woolard Band featuring Craig's son, Craig Michael on the lead vocals. *Bring The Beat In* from Batman And Robin Records is now available for SOS. Friends* is readily available from your favorite outlet.

Batman And Robin Records have been busy. In addition to the *Bring The Beat In* compilation, the company has released *Unplugged House Party* by Dip Ferrell of Dip Ferrell & The Truetones. The album carries 12 songs including remakes of Eddie Floyd's *Never Found A Girl* and The Temptations' *Since I Lost My Baby*. One of my all-time favorite Drifters songs is *Fools Fall In Love*. You just don't hear this song often enough. Dip does a great cover of this classic, as well as a rendition of The Drifters' *Up On The Roof*. Dip's home base is Florence, South Carolina. He and the Truetones

have had success with three albums and are noted for their original hit song, *The Old Rockin'*. Singer Shana Blake is a member of the Truetones, as is renowned musician and producer Don Dixon. Don made a name for himself in the early years singing with cult heroes Amalgance for thirteen years. He co-produced REM's debut album, *Murmur*. Married to singer Marti Jones, Don launched his acting career in 2003 and played an alcoholic director in the 2003 film, *Camp*. Dip Ferrell's *Unplugged House Party* available for the taking



at this year's Fall Migration of SOS.

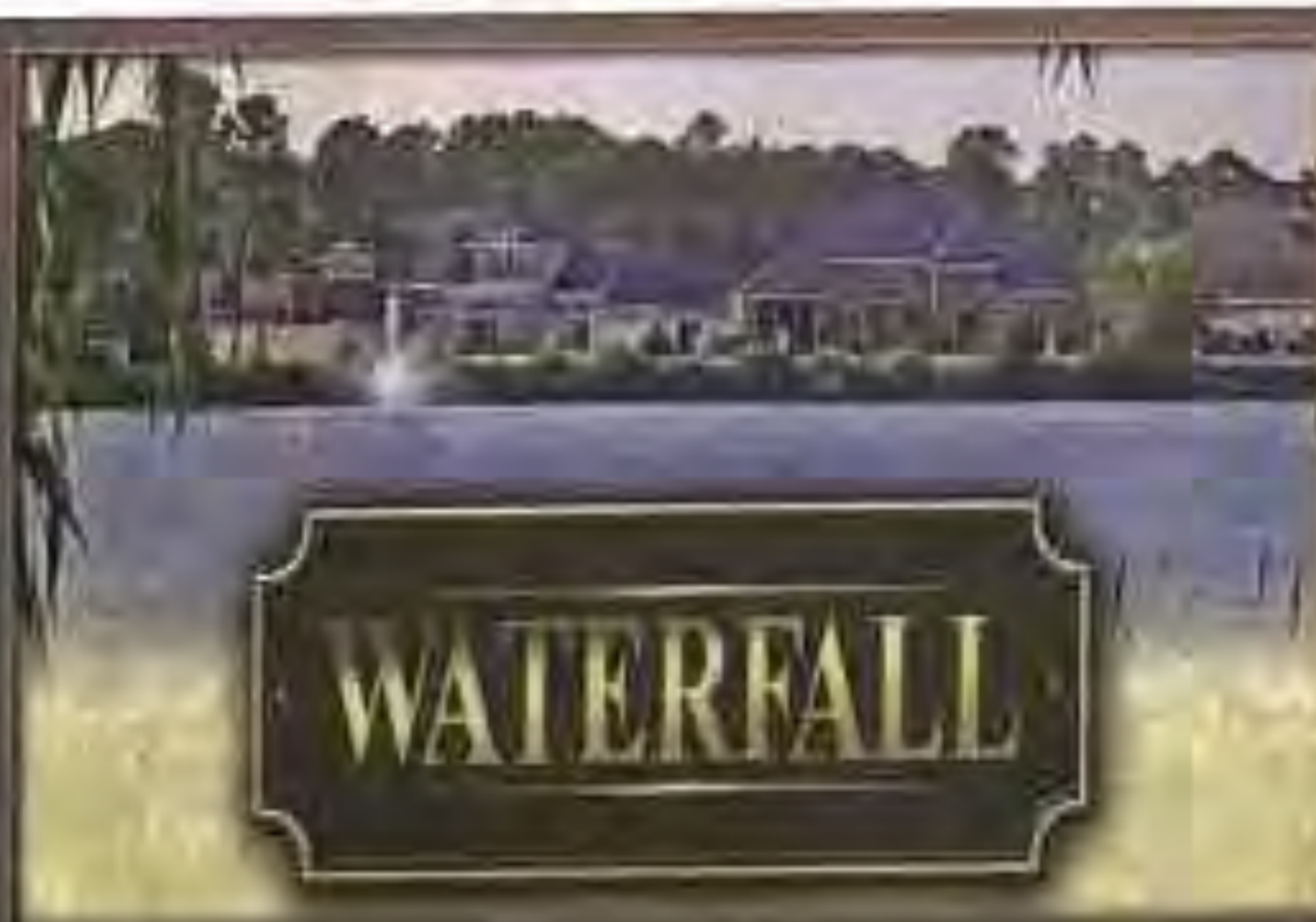

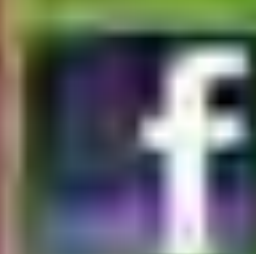

The spring of 2011, we were back for an extended stay and during that time on Easter Sunday, right after church Germany was rushed to the hospital and eventually passed away. During that devastating time, being away from home, my close friends Rabs and Fladi Lachock and Carol Keith spent days in the hospital with me, so that I wouldn't be alone until my family was able to get there. It's funny how things happen in life, looking back at the events that transpired one week before his passing. Germany got to see so people he hadn't seen for some time from back home and from NMB, such as Meryl, Larry and Terry at the Arcade and even talked with various people on the phone. His last evening, we enjoyed the night down on Main Street sitting in front of Duck's, talking with Ted and Kay from 94.9 The Surf, who also dedicated his show to Germany, Drury Trexler, Harry Turner, Billy Scott, Paul Craver and Willie C. That very next day, he left this world in a place he enjoyed, North Myrtle Beach. I know there are many more friends that I didn't mention, but would like to thank all the special people that helped in his wonderful send off. Everyone made him feel loved.

The Real Dr. Phil (and Miss Chick)

He revels in watching shaggers willfully and pleasurably fall prey to something that always seems to hold them captive. For a time at least, thrice a year, their bodies, their minds, and their souls all belong to the Society of Stranders (SOS). Hooked, they anxiously jump at the chance to flock to its Mid-Winter Classic, Spring Safari, and Fall Migration like a convertible full of teenagers each jockeying in ride shotgun. The very thought of SOS causes his heart to swell with pride as he reflects back on his long journey toward making it continually appear and reappear, year after year, like clockwork. Without his efforts, the opportunity to purchase SOS for the Association of Carolina Shag Clubs may have gone wasted. Looking back on it, he knew that, as he put it, "SOS was a fragile house of cards that could tumble at any moment." After all, it was a unique and very peculiar creation. The Society of Stranders, Inc. simply promoted the SOS event, which took place in participating clubs located on, or within walking distance of, Main Street, North Myrtle Beach. It had no ownership in these clubs, and it held no deep grass-roots influence over the shag community, which supports the SOS event. The event, the clubs, and the shaggers merged into a cumbersome, three-way juggle, which became extremely difficult to master. Simplicity was no longer simple and short-term "take-what-we-can-get" talk seemed to be the buzz while long-term unity wasn't even an afterthought.

His reflections take him back to the latter part of 1988 and the early part of 1989 when this fragile house of cards teetered and tottered, and damn near tumbled. SOS was just about washed up and a relic of the past. It had lost favor with club owners and it was losing its core membership offering—dance floor venue with shagger appeal. There were SOS card burnings and grandiose under movements to replace it with some other event with some other name; no one knew exactly what, but it would certainly be spelled without letters "SOS."

Dr. Phil Sawyer, SOS President Emeritus and resident shag historian, is one of the founding fathers of the Association of Carolina Shag Clubs, proudly serving as its third Chairman. En route to smoothly finishing his final year as Chairman, he received an intriguing proposition from long-time friend, Gene "Swink" Laughter, the founder and sole shareholder of the Society of Stranders, Inc. Gene's health was becoming a concern and running SOS as a one-man show, cloning as newsletter "Editor, Publisher, Stamp Licker, Go-fer, etc.," had turned what started as fun into drudgery. After deep solo searching, he reached a decision to offer it for sale to the only



organization he felt could and would continue the SOS tradition he had started—the Association of Carolina Shag Clubs. When Laughter presented him with the offer, Dr. Phil immediately saw it as seminal for advancing the Association's goals and objectives. However, when presented to Association's membership, the offer naturally faced stiff opposition. SOS was slowly sinking and to once again envision it viable would take unpopular foresight. He could clearly see the potential success, however fraught with potential failure. "Failure was not an option." He rallied support and got the Association's approval to purchase SOS. But the tide was far from turning.

The purchase took place toward the end of March, just before the 1989 Spring Safari. His term as the Association's Chairman was now complete and he was the logical choice to become SOS's first post-acquisition president, a position initially carrying the unwritten, but implied, employment clause, "headache without compensation." He took it as a labor of love. The Association of Carolina Shag Clubs, Inc. acquired 100% of the outstanding stock the Society of Stranders, Inc., which follows the cash basis of accounting. With most of the card sales made during the first quarter, this meant that the biggest bulk of the 1989 receipts stayed with the seller while the obligation to sponsor both of the 1989 SOS events passed on to the buyer. The only participating club in the 1989 Spring Safari was Crazy Zacks. Non-participating clubs took in the SOS crowds, and their dough, with no vows to honor SOS cards, thus rendering them nonessential. He now cracked the whip on a tiger with no teeth. Seemingly, as though to pour salt on the wound from a poor financial showing for the spring, Crazy Zacks later entered into an agreement to host another event, "The Grand Party," during SOS weekend, leaving him with no club that would require an SOS card for the upcoming Fall Migration. SOS was now at its lowest point, and even pronounced dead by skeptics.

He knew, for it to succeed, SOS would have to negotiate adequate venue; it would mean consensus participation by the major club owners. Pulling this off would be remote and failure loomed imminent. But he clung to a belief that the synergy of the Association working hand-in-hand with the clubs through SOS would have to produce an effect much greater than the sum of its parts. After all, the Association's individual member clubs cultivate and nourish the shag community, which provides SOS with card-carrying members and the clubs with beer-drinking customers. SOS brings this to the doorsteps of the clubs, which in turn provide venue. How simple is that? One doing it without the reinforcement of the other cannot possibly yield the maximum potential. Done all together as one well-oiled machine could skyrocket the yield.

With help from his friend, then SOS Vice-President, Speedy Lewis, he was able to overcome many of the obstacles that lay between SOS and the club owners. Speedy is an influential North Myrtle Beach business owner who over the years had developed excellent working relationships with area businesses. They were able to land a commitment from the Spanish Galleon to become a participating club for the 1989 Fall Migration. The Spanish Galleon customarily receives significant door-cover receipts from its regular daily operations. In order to make participation in SOS worthwhile, a new concept, later coined "floor-space rental," became part of the negotiations. Floor-space rental is an amount SOS agrees to pay participating clubs to compensate for foregone regular door revenue while making the club exclusively available for SOS members. This concept would play a key role in maintaining accord with club owners for years to come. With the Spanish Galleon on board and the newly conceived offer of floor-space rental in their hip pockets, they were able to reopen negotiations with other club owners and win over their participation in the upcoming 1989 Fall Migration. He now had consensus participation, and much more—he had hope for the future. This one coup provided the desperately needed venue that had been missing in the 1989 Spring Safari. Finally, this fragile house of cards was beginning to build a solid foundation.

In an article that he wrote for "Carefree Times" entitled "Why We Pay The Clubs A Floor Charge" he states, "Make no mistake, without this agreement in 1989, there would have been no Fall Migration, and S.O.S. would have been bankrupt and been a long lost memory. I don't have to tell you where the Association would be without the support of S.O.S. Many of the newer members of the Association would simply have sat around hundreds of bars on thousands of nights listening to the old timer's talk about the way it used to be. "Boy, you should have been there..."

Had Dr. Phil not possessed this fire-in-his-belly passion for SOS, the 1989 Fall Migration may never have happened. Anything less than an

inspired and carefully orchestrated effort would not have worked; there was no possibility for a second chance. Other interested parties stood to benefit handsomely from SOS's demise. Had he failed in 1989, SOS would have scattered-out and imitations bearing no resemblance to SOS, as we know it today, would have become the fad. But like all fads, they would have faded away, and unlike the real thing, they would hold no means to create and foster unity for powering the cogs that turn SOS. Dr. Phil has taught us that this unity, which we enjoy today, is paramount to our success. It requires constant maintenance and calibration for the mutual benefit of its individual parts. To let one card teeter could tumble the entire house.

He has brilliantly entertained us with his fascinating articles written in numerous beach and shag-dance publications, and we chuckled at his jokes as he customarily adjourned each Association meeting. Proper and fitting he is often introduced as the "Godfather of Shag," which always brings a smile to his face. His tutelage has left us well prepared for future tests of survival. But he did not go it alone; As the saying goes, "Behind every great man is a great woman." And behind Dr. Phil is his wife and soul mate, Debra, better known as "Miss Chick." She has ridden shotgun the entire distance, and along the way withstood every jolting bump in the trail. Without her, Dr. Phil would not be the "real Dr. Phil," he would be just plain old "Phil."

Illness, mishaps, and Father Time have taken their toll on Dr. Phil and Miss Chick. Stove-up by Parkinson's disease, Dr. Phil has suffered several severe falls knocking out a few front teeth and breaking his right arm several places with compound fractures. He has been immobile, undergoing inpatient rehabilitation for his weak knees, and is now finally able to move about with a hand walker. Miss Chick has also taken a fall, breaking two bones in the top of her left foot. For a while, she sported a Gamacock cast extending from her left foot toes on up to her left knee. They both may be physically slow to stand, but their spirits rise with the morning sun and faithfully carry them throughout each day. Their days have been long and fruitful, and they know that dusk will eventually appear over the horizon. But they rest easy, because the end of the day cannot reclaim the joy that every minute of each day together gives them.

The fruit of experience from Dr. Phil's labor of love as ACSC Chairman, SOS President, SOS President Emeritus, and shagger-at-large will ripen with the dawn of his newly published book, "Save the Last Dance for Me." It can be hand-picked and stamped with authenticity during Fall Migration at The Company Store. Keep Dr. Phil and Miss Chick in your prayers, for they need no TV show to prove they are the original, real "Dr. Phil (and Miss Chick)."
