The years of SPA were great and all organizations go through trials and tribulations, opinions...but all of you who attended, competed know how much fun we had and I'm sorry that there is not many shag clubs to support SPA as the past. But we have great memories and SPA is not dissolved at this point....but this was Fat Harold's final SPA but WILL continue to have shag contests.

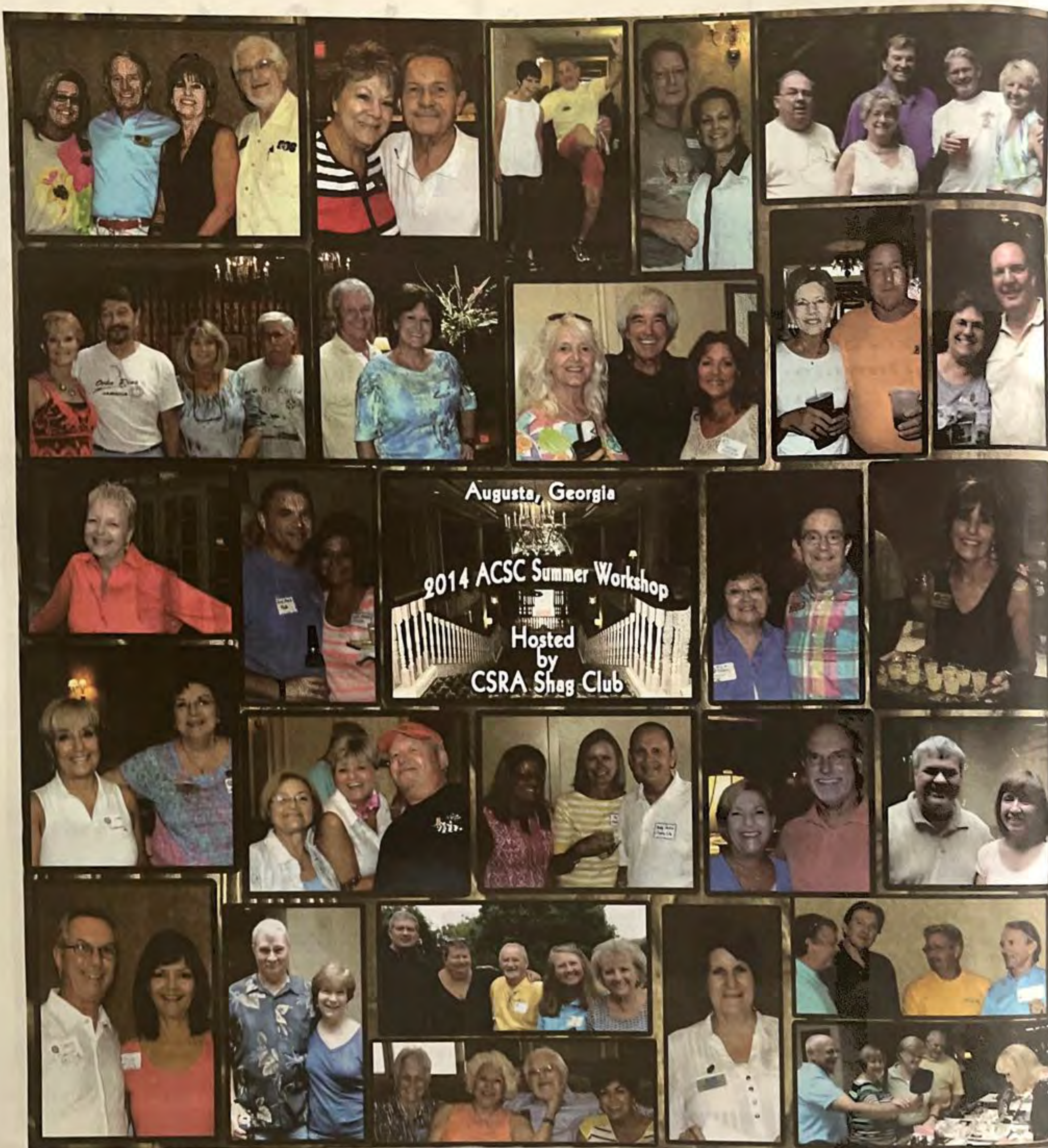

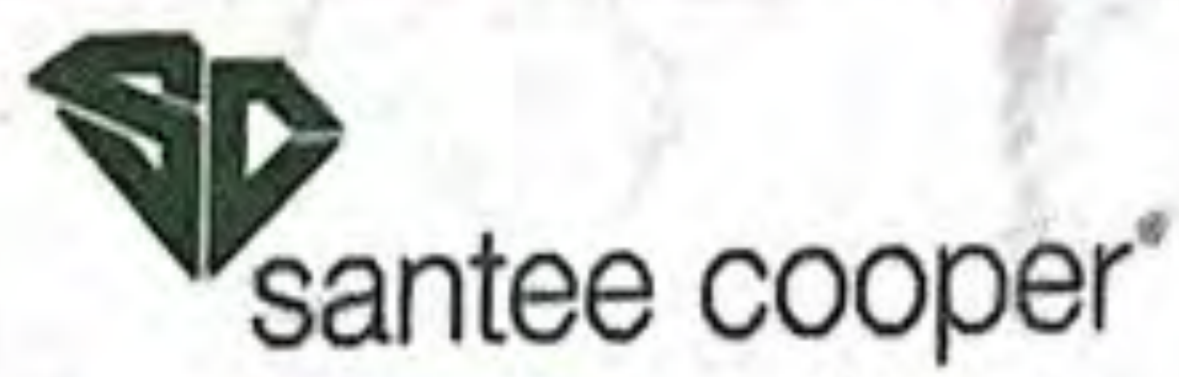

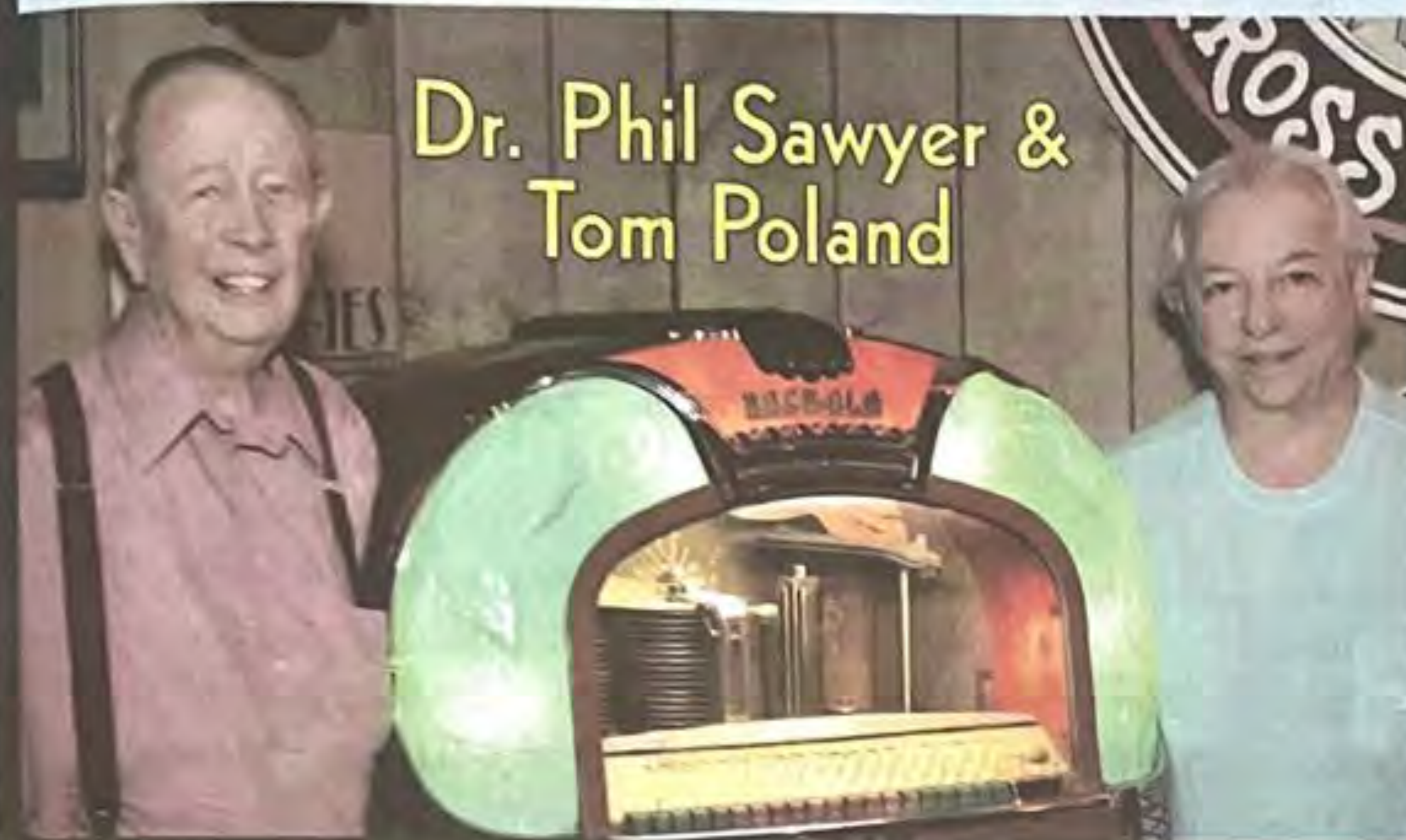

# 72 Summers in The Land of Shag

Come the summer of 2015, the shag dance will celebrate its 72nd anniversary of conception.

It came to pass in June of 1943 that gut-level rhythm and blues, the original rock n roll arrived on jukeboxes along the Carolina coast, and the kids called it Beach Music. They danced up a storm, and the shag was conceived. A unique form in American dance culture, descended from West European influences as diverse as the minuet, the waltz, and the highland fling -- cross fertilized with the jitterbug -- the shag began evolving the moment Beach Music found the dancers.

72 years ago, come the summer of 2015.

Flashing forward from 1943, down the decades of haphazard, hand-me-down survival, through the '60's and '70's, everybody knows the shag endured just barely. Then came SOS, an organization and a dance party, with a name the same as the international telegraph code for vessels in distress -- Society Of Stranders, Save Our Ship.

And so it was, the dance was not simply saved or preserved, but transformed into something that dazzles and lives in the law of the land, immortal, so long as North Carolina and South Carolina retain official state dances.

The shag has evolved in complexity of movement never seen when my generation was fourteen, eighteen, and twenty years old. In July of this year, at the Junior SOS event, I was mesmerized, not least because the number of young kids dancing has increased so dramatically.

Twenty years ago, I wrote a best-selling book called *Shag: The Legendary Dance of the South*. Then you could fit just about all the junior dancers in the shag world into one three by five inch photograph. Sam West still had just about all of his hair, David Campbell still had a baby face, Matt Free looked like a poster boy for Greek week at Chapel Hill. Kristen Leggett, Sarah West, and Kristal Taylor had recently put their

childhood baby dolls in storage.

It was a different time in The Land of Shag, early in the lifespan of juniors who now bring their own children to the music, teach their kids and other kids to dance. The shag was always handed down parent to child, sibling to sibling, and from what I saw in July, grandparents often impart the dance, and what is more, the manners and social grace of the post-Victorian South, such that young kids learning to shag dance today are very likely to become and remain ladies and gentlemen forever. That is rare and can open more doors to success than an Ivy League diploma.

Sam West, who now teaches juniors professionally, told me, "A lot of kids start out shy, especially the boys. Then they learn to dance and confidence comes on them they didn't have before. Most of them make better grades in school too. I'm not sure why, but it happens."

At Junior SOS, there were kids dancing who could not have been older than five or six. I saw little ones partnered with teenagers, grandparents dancing with grand kids, parents even dancing with each other. I saw genuine camaraderie, not just older people tolerating the young, or the young impatient to shed the company of elders; I saw respect, admiration, and love directed all around. This was a family, everyone was a member, and the blood tie was the music.

A couple of weeks later, I was in Fat Harold's, just to look around, cause I hadn't been there in so long. After I wrote the shag book, I disappeared to an island without a bridge and raised three kids as a single father. That's another story.

Fat Harold's was just about the same. There was an actual granite sculpture of Harold's head in miniature that hadn't been there before, and a lot of new pictures of dancers, and Camp Kemo, and party memorabilia. There was a good crowd for a Wednesday night. I ran into Johnny Barringer, one of the old boys from Myrtle

Beach who came back. Barringer knew everybody in the joint. I was envious of him, but nothing fundamental was changed. The music is in my blood as well. My family was where I left it, my oldest friends are here.

In the back room at Harold's was a wall of pictures, of children now grown who were kids but twenty years ago, The Keepers of the Dance. Each was an element in the evolution of the shag, champion dancers; some students of Shad Alberty or Miss Ellen Taylor, both legendary now with charitable foundations named in their honor. Shad departed this life with wings on his heels, now has a scholarship fund named after him. Miss Ellen supports juniors, her foundation gives away hundreds of pairs of dancing shoes each year, and aids juniors however possible. The Shag Hall of Fame and The Hall of Fame Foundation are the ultimate safety net for senior boogie walkers. The Society of Stranders and The Association of Carolina Shag Clubs are the heart and muscle of the shag culture today. The Junior Shag Association, founded by Ron Alexander and his friends, currently headed by Gene Pope, is the future. All members of all the clubs and organizations devoted, anyone who ever learned the basic step is a keeper of the dance in my book.

In 2015, the shag celebrates 72 years of evolution and wedlock to the rhythms of summer, Beach Music. In The Land of Shag, the night is young forever. The music never ages.

The dance goes on for silver foxes and silver soldiers of the generation that boomed. We rocked and rolled and unveiled the power of youth to shape the future.

The torch is lit, the kids are dancing.

We venerate those who came before us, who discovered Beach Music and conceived the shag, the only first dance of The Rock and Roll Revolution. Amen.

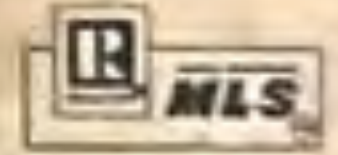

The evening came to a close with a live auction. We have had some marvelous and creative gifts to auction in the past and this year was no different. Rock Hill is a very giving community and our members are always more than willing to open up their hearts to such a worthwhile cause.

Vegas night is always a work in progress and is planned and executed by our Ways and Means Committee and club members. The amount of work it takes to make this event happen is incredible and they deserve all of the credit for the success of the event. 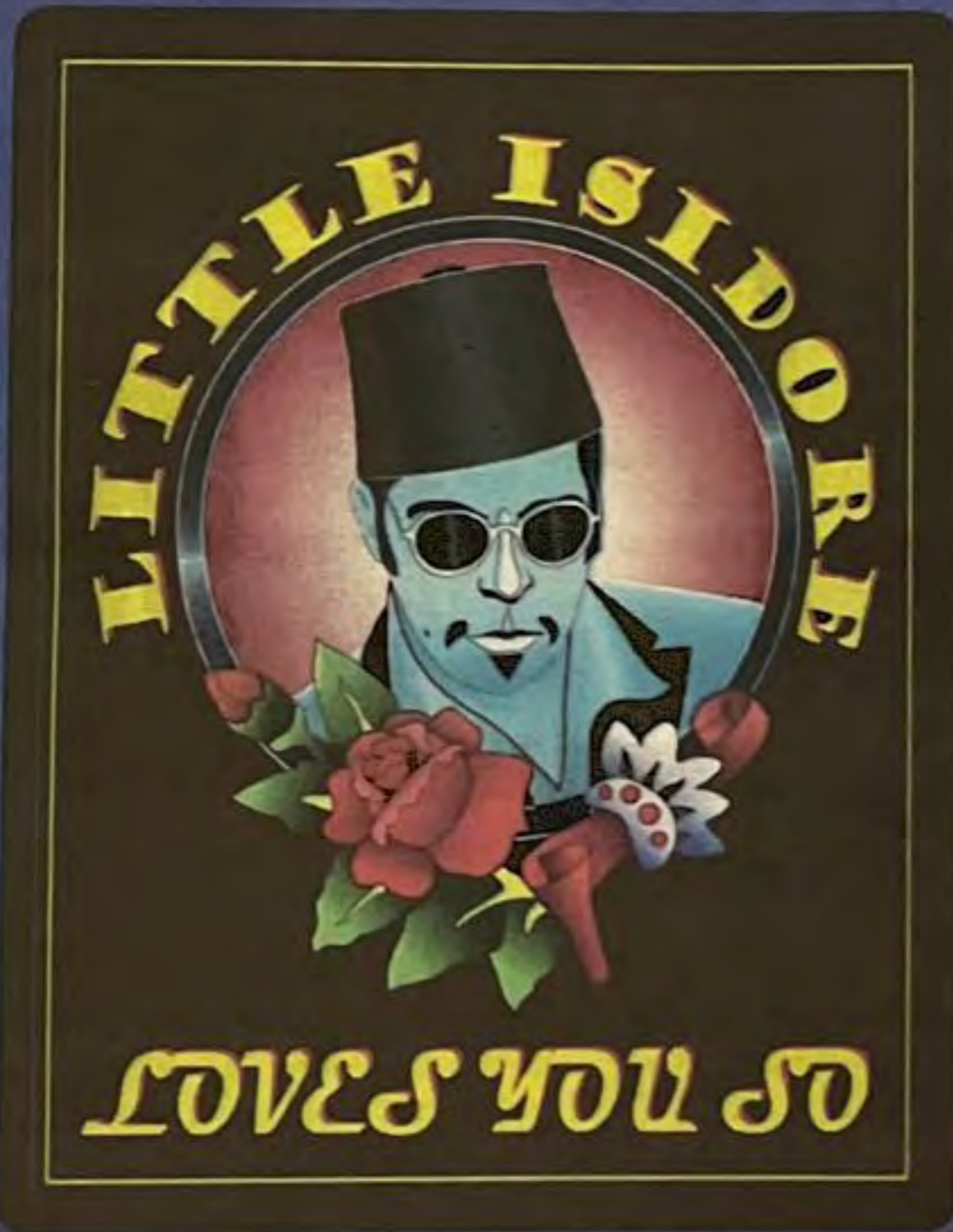

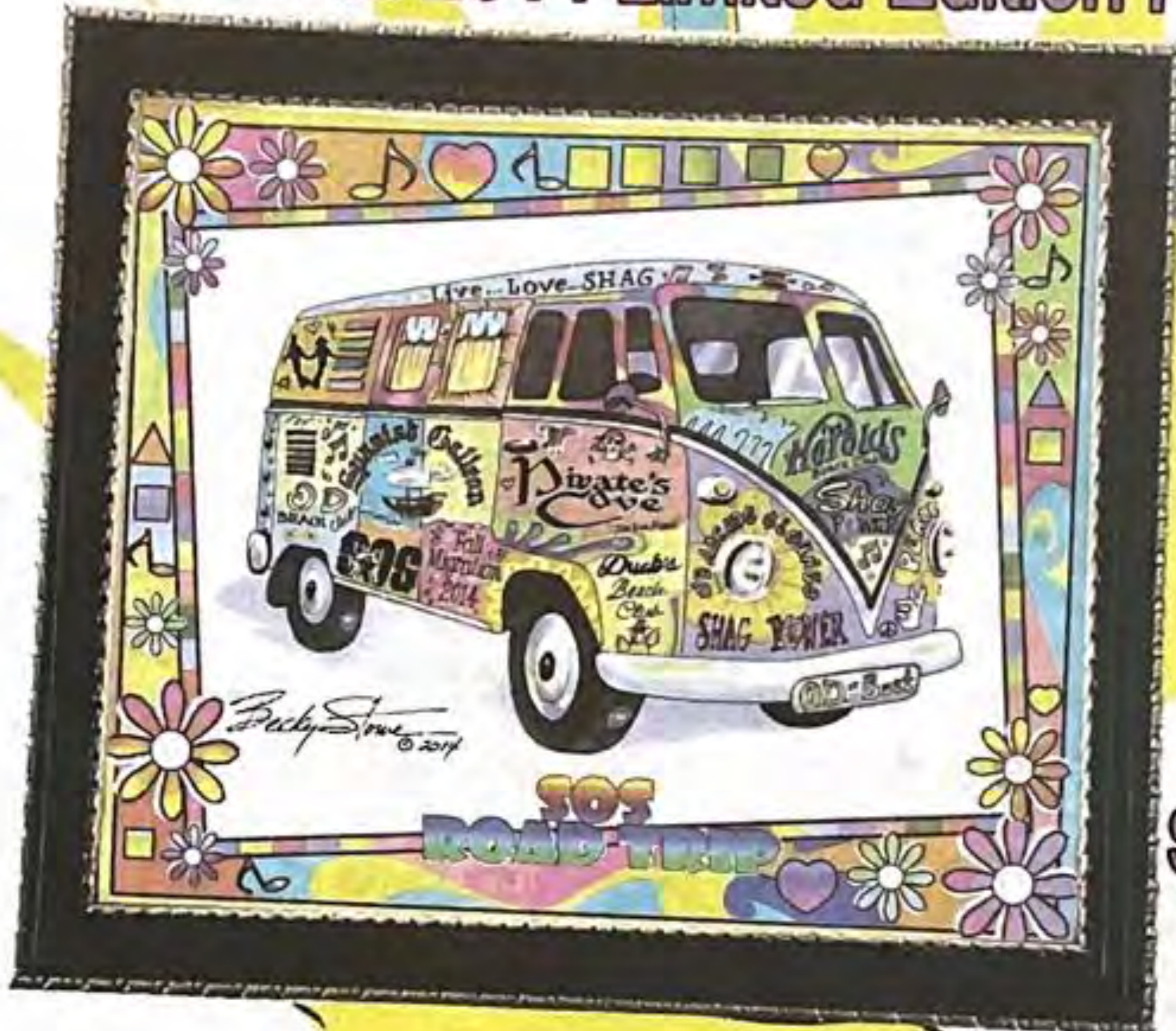

# Lesya Hudson's "Step Out in Faith"

She needs no rabbit's foot, no genie in a bottle, nor magic potion to conjure up good fortune. Good fortune is relative and holds different values for different people. It is within her nature to find it abounding in simple blessings. I can easily picture her chasing rainbows and finding rays of sunshine in small measures of modesty that in the end tender far greater value than pots of gold. Rainbows, occasionally appearing across the sky in the aftermath of a storm, are signs of safe haven. Many things in life can precipitate violent storms desperately searching for rainbows. Finding the one takes a lot more than just good fortune—it takes a bold step out in faith. Every day, Lesya Hudson steps out in faith and follows rainbows the Word of God shows her. With her song "Step Out in Faith," she challenges others to follow, assuring them that "it's the only way to do it because if He takes you there, He'll be there to lead you through it." As a highly talented and accomplished singer, songwriter, and musician, Lesya steps out with pronounced footprints of musical notes and lyrics. They trace her inspirational footsteps for others who wish to step out in faith and follow the grace the Good Lord gives with rainbows.

Many of us beach music enthusiasts are well acquainted with Lesya's most recent hit, "Amazingly Amazing," which topped the beach music charts at number one. We love to stroll out onto the dance floor hand-in-hand with our dance partner, then cuddle-up, sway and lightly dip to her hit smoothie, "When You Look at Me"—it still raises goose bumps. We celebrate Christmas with her holiday shuffle, "Santa Can You Teach Me How to Shag." We enjoy her center-stage performances alongside Rick Strickland with the award-winning Rick Strickland Band. We admire her two CBMA Cammys and we cheer her on for more—even pushing for a Grammy. But most of us are less acquainted with the contemporary Christian side of Lesya Hudson's musical repertoire. As a matter of fact, this is the genre in which she first launched her musical career.



Lesya comes from a family whose musical background and Christian faith are central focuses. They have been passionately engrained and passed down for generations. Lesya's mother played piano at church worship services for over thirty-five years while her father sang bass in the choir of the First Church of God in their hometown of Darlington, South Carolina—a church for which her ancestors were founding members. Lesya jests that when her mother was pregnant with her, she is sure that while in the womb her head would rest against the piano as her mother played. Her brother and sisters also sing in church, and many of her aunts, uncles, and cousins, who are musically inclined, also proudly carry on their family's musical heritage. Taught by her church's music director, Lesya began her musical journey with piano lessons at age six. As a teenager, she followed in her mother's footsteps and began playing piano for church worship services. At first it seemed like a chore that any youngster would naturally come to dread.

But as time passed, she began to see little blessings snowball into huge blessings. She found that through her simple gift of playing piano she could positively touch the complex lives of other people. This realization strengthened her faith and eventually led her to expand out into writing and producing contemporary Christian music. In 1995, she along with two other church members—her niece Debbie Anderson, who currently joins Lesya in the Rick Strickland band as bassist and backup vocalists, and her distance relative Heather Anderson Corbett—founded a contemporary Christian music trio named N' Accord. It was a harmonious vocal and musical trio dedicated full-sail to praise and worship releasing three CD's in the wake of their musical inspirations—*Here to Worship* in 2004, *Christmas Joy* in 2005, and *Worship* in 2007.



In May 2006, Lesya released her first solo CD, entitled *Not Me*, which included nine songs she had written or co-written. Three of these songs charted on several Christian Country music billboards—"Not Me" peaked at number eight on the PowerSource Christian Country Top 100 (June 2007) and number eleven on the Christian Country Music Weekly (January 2007); "Lukewarm Christian" peaked at number three on the PowerSource Christian Country Top 100 (January 2008); and "Step Out in Faith" peaked at number two on the PowerSource Christian Country Top 100 (January 2007) and number eight on the Christian Music Weekly (November 2008). "Step Out in Faith" also peaked at number eleven in January 2007 on the PowerSource Top 20 syndicated radio program hosted by Rich Miller. It airs on eighty U.S. stations covering nearly three-thousand cities and gives playing time to such renowned country music artists as Tim McGraw, Rascal Flatts, Sara Evans, Joe Nichols and many others. "Step Out in Faith" is one of those powerful, inspirational songs to which you instantly grow attached. It seems to just stop you dead in your tracks and force you to listen and think.

Many songs from the *Not Me* CD, along with a treasure trove of others, are featured on the *Lesya Hudson Live @ The Center Theater* CD and DVD, released in June 2008. Both, the CD and DVD, capture Lesya with her band, The Lesya Hudson Band, live in concert on March 7, 2008 at the beautiful Historic Center Theater in Hartsville, South Carolina. One song written by Lesya, in particular, performed during what she refers to as the "acoustic set" of the concert, entitled "Field of Dreams," just really snares your heart. The song is brilliantly written and chronicles the dreams of



a little league baseball player. Its lyrics make it a pure gem worthy of sparkling right here on this printed page. They flow together beautifully in part like this—

“See the little league ballplayer with his cap turned to the side. He’s ready for the majors, although he’s only five. He knows he’s gonna be the best the world has ever seen. He’s gonna be a big star on this field of dreams. His daddy showed him how to catch and to lay one down the line. But he gets so discouraged if he misses just one time. Well his daddy kneels beside him and says son listen to me. There’s so much more to baseball than you can ever dream. And he said, ‘Welcome to my field of dreams where the sun’s always shining and the grass grows tall and green. Son you might not always win here; that’s not bad as it seems. You’ll leave a better man from my field of dreams.’”

Many years down the road we find the boy that we once knew has now become a teacher and his playing days are through. Well he never made the majors; it just wasn’t meant to be. It seems the Lord was working on a different destiny. There’s a brotherhood of souls who have walked across the plate learning from his presence how to live through love and faith. There are so many men who’ve been blessed by what they’ve seen because they’ve learned much more than baseball on this field of dreams. Well now *they* say, ‘Welcome to my field of dreams where the sun’s always shining and the grass grows tall and green. Son you might not always win here; that’s not bad as it seems. You’ll leave a better man from my field of dreams.’”

“Field of Dreams” is about Lesa’s husband, Curtis, who is a teacher and head baseball coach at Socastee High School in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina. Lesa says it’s a tribute to a wonderful husband who is also guided by faith.

I had the great pleasure of visiting and interviewing Lesa at her home in Murrells Inlet, South Carolina, which includes the in-home recording studio where “Amazingly Amazing” and many of her other beach music hits were recorded. I curiously asked her exactly how songwriting works. She indicated that there is no secret formula or recipe for songwriting. You just work at it and develop your own niche. She maintains a composition notebook where she collects her thoughts for putting songs together. She says that sometimes these thoughts may not be fully composed into a finished song right away—they may be set aside and patiently wait for years. It all depends on a lot of different variables such as timing, inspiration or just simply finding the right fit. As an example, she opened the notebook, found and pointed to the page dated January 10, 2008 on which she jotted down the chord progression along with her thoughts for “Amazingly Amazing,” which originally started out as a praise and worship song. Each thought was put into a phrase that was numbered with an encircled numeral—a couple were scratched through and renumbered. The final numbers are the sequence in which the phrases would end up within the song. This is just a glimpse of how songwriting works for Lesa Hudson. Although it is not a secret formula or recipe, her approach appears to be working very well. It earned her two Carolina Beach Music Award Cammys in 2011 for Smoothie of the Year and Songwriter of the Year for her signature song, “When You Look at Me”—her first single release from her second solo CD entitled *Sweet Wonderful You*. Although, it is not a praise and worship CD, *Sweet Wonderful you*, as stated in her biographical write-up, is a collection of ten songs about love, life and relationships.



In addition to her beach music awards, Lesa has a long list of accolades for her contemporary Christian country music efforts, which include being a three-time finalist for the Inspirational Country Music Awards (ICMA) Female Vocalist of the Year and a two-time finalist for the ICMA New Artist of the Year. Lesa made a big splash when she was chosen for the cover of PowerSource magazine’s January 2007 issue as its “Artist to Watch for 2007.” She spent valuable time in Nashville, Tennessee, performing in many of its legendary venues.

True happiness can only come with self-fulfillment. Self-fulfillment to Lesa Hudson has to be singing, playing music, and writing songs. She feels extremely blessed with all the good things in life she has experienced. Her cup runneth over with good fortune from the ability to do the things that she does best. She says faith is the key. The notion that the end of a rainbow is the secret hiding place for an Irish leprechaun’s pot of gold is, of course, just a myth. Or is it? We’ll never know, because rainbows, just like faith, have no end.

Instructors donate their time teaching workshops, DJ's donate their time playing music and sponsors make sure that the 'kids' have what they need for this event. The Clubs at Ocean Drive virtually turn their facilities over to the juniors during Junior SOS.

When I walked up to this young lady, she said something like, "Ms. Carter my name is Ashton Cox and I got your shoes"!!! What are the chances, out of all the Juniors at S.O.S., I would ever meet her. I was overwhelmed. She is such a lovely young

lady and already quite a pretty, smooth shagger. I am still amazed.
