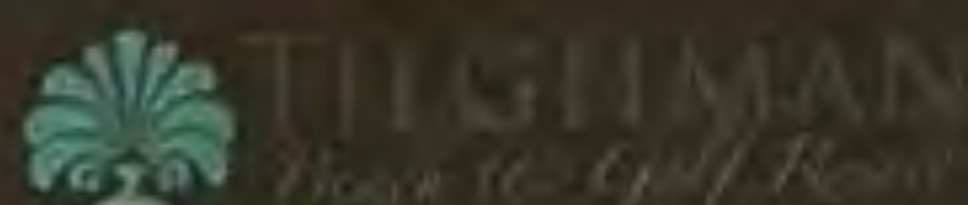

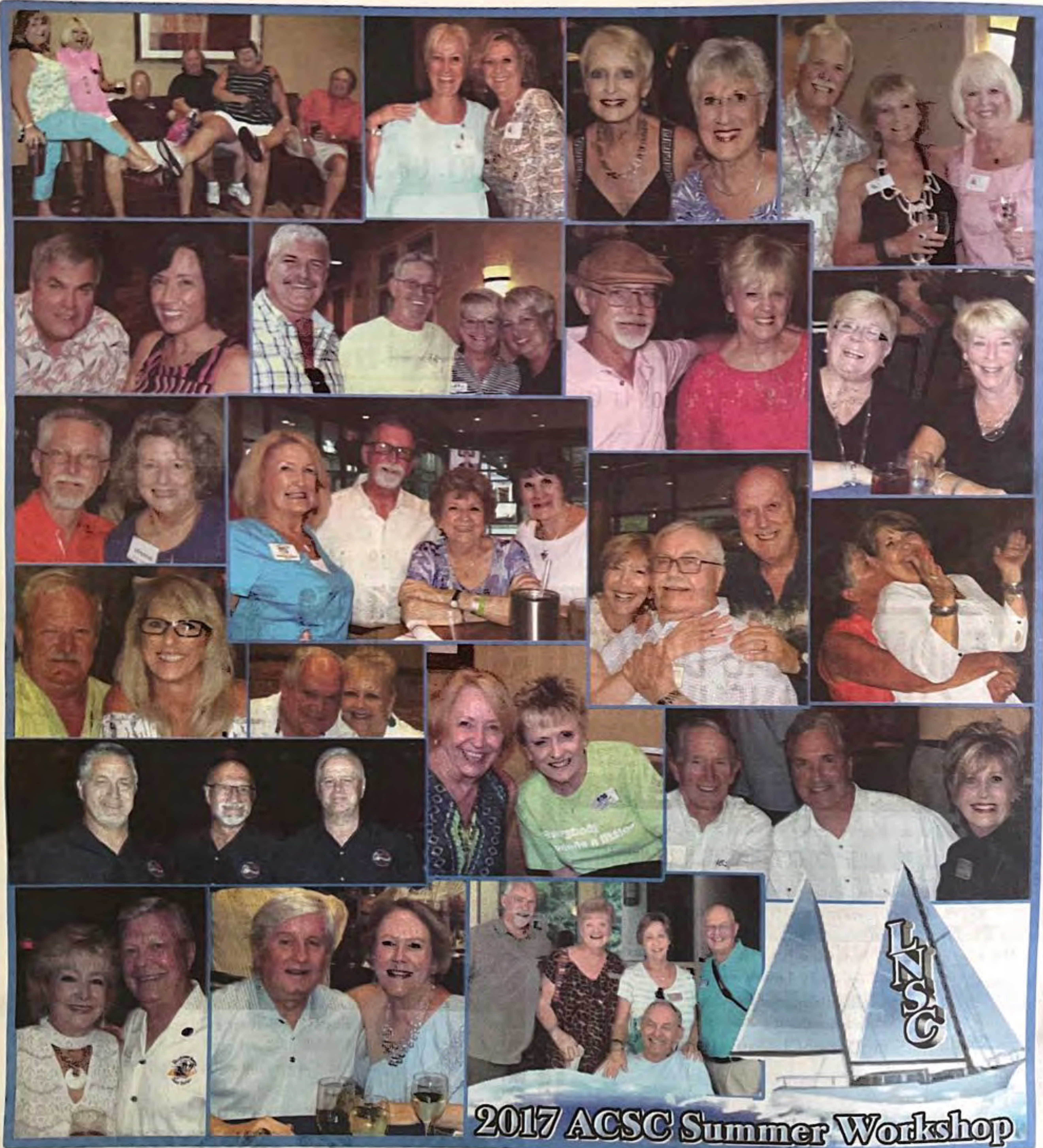

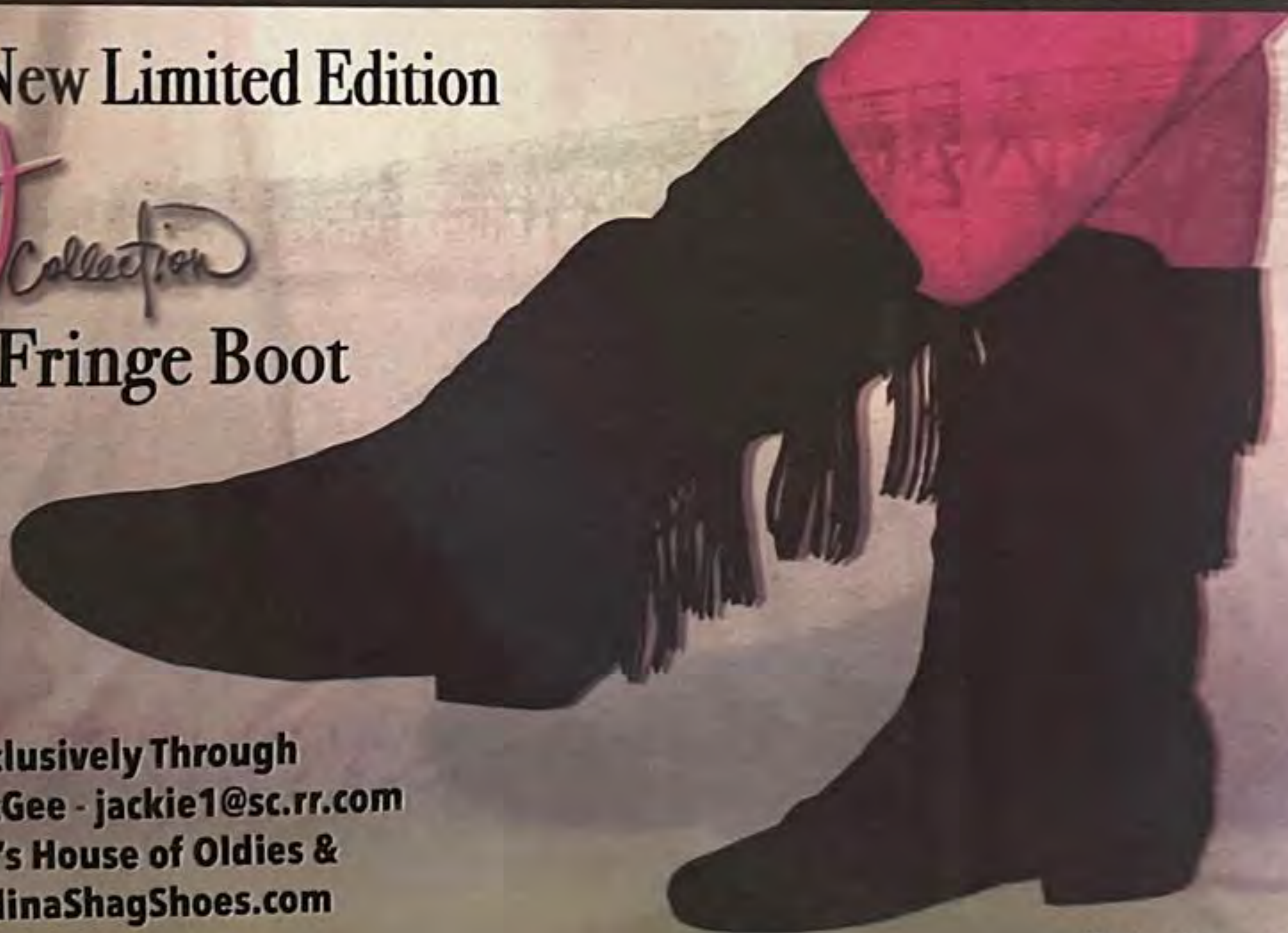

BEACH MEMORIES, A FAREWELL BY BECKY STOWE



It is with mixed emotions that I announce that this will be my last SOS in my brick and mortar store at 219 Main Street, Ocean Drive section of N. Myrtle Beach.

Over 28 years ago during the spring of 1989 my dream came true when I opened Beach Memories at 204 Main Street. It was a tiny little building next to Hardwick's Cafeteria which is now an ice cream store. Three years later I moved my store across the street into the vacated Jade Jeweler's store. While there we expanded the art gallery and Memories store and added custom picture framing, tee shirt printing, jewelry and coastal gifts. We operated there for 17 years then sold that building in 2008. We have been in our present location at 219 Main Street for 9 years.

Oh, the memories I could share with you if I had the space but I am going to share a couple. *I experienced my first big hurricane during my first year on Main Street. Legendary "Hugo" left a big nasty mess. Debris could be seen for blocks up Main Street! Coolers from the Spanish Galleon were at the traffic light of Main and Hillside. Mini liquor bottles, trees, lumber and an assortment of "anything" you could imagine were scattered everywhere! Stores that had broken windows were looted because the National Guard had not arrived yet. *Christmas Eve that same year, I witnessed 13 inches of snow! *In 1999 hurricane "Floyd" paid us a visit and rained heavily for hours. My store suffered a foot or more of water. And Fall SOS was to begin in two days! Panic set in! After the water receded, our friends, customers and employees came to help clean up. We pulled all the carpets out of the store and spread them out in Hardwick's Cafeteria parking lot to let the sun dry them. We were up and open the next day. I had a lot of damage and no insurance but it was still a good SOS!

*Once in the early nineties during a flash flood we watched some young boys float their nice BMW sedan across the "Horseshoe" to higher ground. When they opened the car doors water gushed out! *Once one early morning during an SOS a cute couple came into my store in their pajamas! We watched them shop for a while then I had to ask about their attire! They explained they didn't have time to dress because they were in a hurry to get to my shop before the good stuff was gone! *Many celebrities have graced our store. Vanna White has been in and purchased several of my prints and Priscilla Pressley dropped by and hung out with Zachary McDonald one day while he was working. A couple years ago Myrtle Manor reality TV stars Myrtle Manor Anne and Marvin rode in the SOS parade with me and Milford then returned to the store for autographs. What a great couple. Anne and I still keep in touch. We have also met several pro ball players and of course some great beach music entertainers!

I want to express my gratitude to all of you for your kindness, love, support and friendship all these years! It was a good run! But that's just words. To celebrate my retirement from brick and mortar and to thank you for your support all these years I am offering you a special shopping experience at Beach Memories during this SOS. 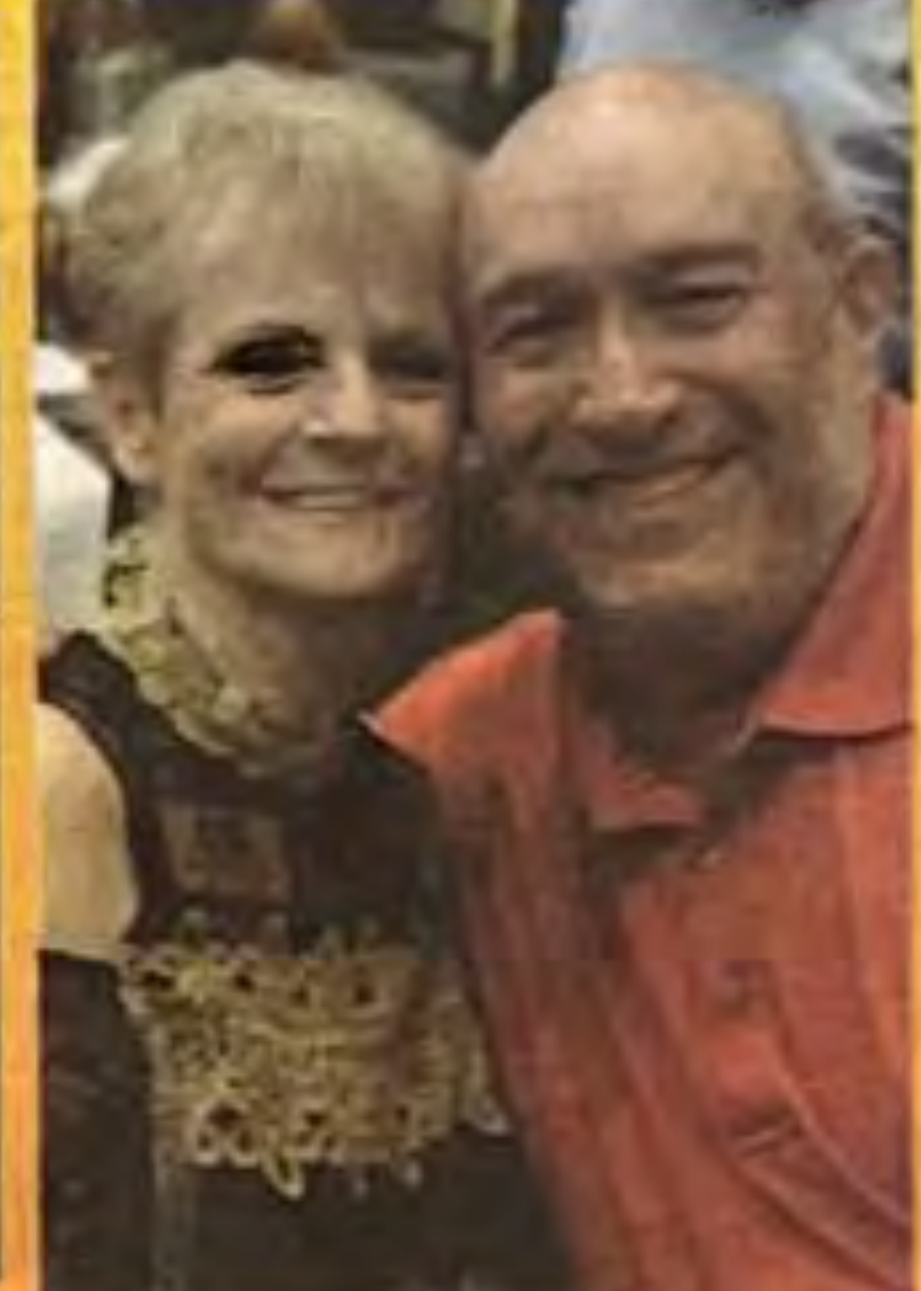

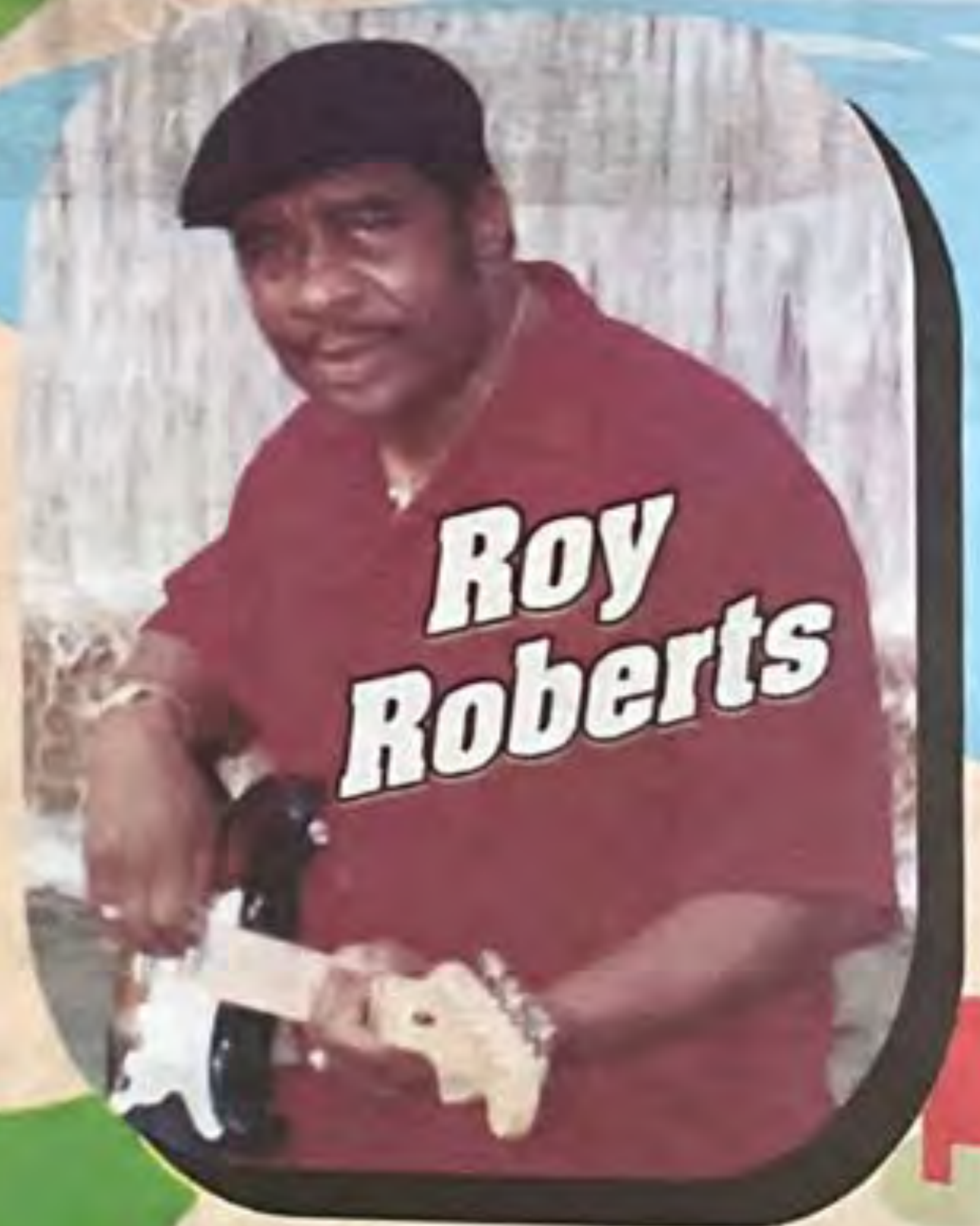

CALE AND THE TALE (TAIL)



Cale Yarborough is beyond a legend in NASCAR racing. Beginning his career in 1957 and driving his last race in 1988 he competed in 560 races, winning 83 and finishing in the top 10 319 times. Along the way he won 3 NASCAR championships and the Daytona 500 known as The Great American Race 4 times. He began owning his own race team in 1987 and continued as

owner for 13 years before retiring in 1999. He is listed as one of the top 10 all-time drivers in NASCAR.

He was born in Sardis, SC and raised in Timmonsville, a small town about 10 miles from my hometown of Florence. Growing up Cale acquired a reputation as somewhat of a daredevil, but also that of a young man with an utmost determination to succeed in NASCAR, as well as in other aspects of life.

Some of the "tales" surrounding Cale are as follows:

He once was diving into his favorite swimming hole on a local river and encountered what he thought was a log only to discover it was an alligator, approximately 8' long. Living in an area where gators were common he knew if he could keep the mouth closed he had a decent chance of survival. After grasping the mouth firmly, he and the gator rolled over and over in the water until getting near the bank where Cale got a footing on the bottom and scrambled out pushing the gator away. Witnesses said both were glad to be rid of one another.

Cale and a buddy bought an old Piper Cub together. Cale's dad had a plane and Cale had flown with him many times as a child. Unfortunately, when Cale was only 10 years old his dad was killed in a crash on the way home from Myrtle Beach. This however didn't dampen Cale's enthusiasm for flying. Before the purchase of the old Piper Cale had alluded to his soon to be partner that he was adapted to flying. His friend told him that he could fly as well. At the initial flight, each partner urged the other to make the takeoff. It became a stalemate until Cale agreed to do it. After all he had watched his dad do it several times. Getting off the ground was uneventful. He found himself getting use to the ups and downs, simple turns, etc. They flew around for about an hour with Cale asking his partner to take his turn at the wheel. Each time he told Cale no and that he was fine just riding along. Cale soon realized they were running low on daylight and fuel. Knowing nothing about landing he ask his new partner to take the wheel. That's when his friend fessed up and said he had never flown a plane. Neither had Cale

but he figured it had to be like taking off only in reverse. He tried landing several times but at the last moment it felt as if something was pushing the plane back up. With almost zero fuel Cale devised a plan. He would come back around, line up with the runway and shut off the engine. That way the plane would have to come down. Well..... much to their unadmitted surprise it worked! The landing was somewhat bumpy, but away walked a proud Cale Yarborough. He became a more proficient pilot as time went on.

Owning a plane led to skydiving. Cale and another friend would each take turns jumping on weekends at the small Timmonsville airport and entertaining the locals who would gather to watch. One particular afternoon Cale was sitting in the plane's cabin next to the exit door preparing for a jump when a sudden unexpected movement of the plane tossed him out. He immediately realized he was not completely harnessed in. He held on to the unattached pieces and deployed the chute only to find out the chute would not open completely. Falling much too fast he ended up in a farmer's freshly plowed field, badly bruised but alive, and with no broken bones.

He once jumped off the porch of his mother's house only to land next to a rattlesnake. Upon seeing the snake he tried to high step it to safety. But the snake was faster and planted his fangs into Cale's foot. After being rushed to a doctor and having medical procedures he spent several days being a very sick young man.

One afternoon Cale was watching a fearsome electrical storm through the window of his house when a lightning bolt struck the yard sending a fireball toward the window. Next thing he knew was waking up across the room next to a tv. The window was blown out and the furniture was in complete disarray but he was none the worse!

While Cale and a friend were at a drive-in restaurant one night with two girls a man flashed the girls. Cale saw this and immediately got out of the car and confronted the man, who appeared to be drunk. The man pulled a gun and when Cale tried to push the gun away it fired a bullet right between Cale's big toe and second toe barely breaking the skin, however ruining a good pair of cowboy boots. The man ran away!

In 1968 the June race in Rockingham, NC got rained out, so Cale decided to fly his Bonanza back home for the evening. It seemed that the storm was moving away from the Florence area. He got his wife Betty Jo and young daughter Juliet seated in and they took off that afternoon in a light rain. He climbed to 5000 feet looking for the ceiling of the storm but only found more dense rainfall. After leveling off at 13000 feet they encountered heavy winds which were blowing them all over the sky. He began to realize they were in trouble. The engine was

The Fayetteville Area Shaggers Hall of Fame was the idea of the late Eddie Monsour who had many titles: FASA's founder, FASA's first President, Chairman of the FASA Perpetual Board, Fayetteville Area Shaggers' Hall of Fame charter member, Beach Shaggers Hall of Fame member and Chairman of the Hall of Fame Foundation just to name a few of his endeavors and honors. The Hall of Fame was near and dear to his heart.

The Fayetteville Area Shag Association Perpetual Board of Directors plans and hosts the annual event that recognizes those associated with the Fayetteville area who have contributed to the dance, the music and the atmosphere surrounding the dance. The Perpetual Board of Directors includes Chairman Dwayne Baggett, Secretary Dawn Carr, Treasurer Elsie Holden, Correspondence Barbara Peele and members Kathi Baloyot, Jerry Dean, Cathy Fann, Linda Wheeler Gurnik, Steve Miller, Joyce Ramos and David Sessoms.

Those celebrating the event included Hall of Fame members, friends and families of the inductees as well as members of FASA and other shag clubs. They were treated to a wonderful evening featuring a lavish buffet, music by ABSCDJ Hall of Fame DJ David Sessoms and plenty of time to dance and socialize. Fayetteville Area Shaggers' Hall of Fame members received very special invitations to the event featuring a photo of their original individual Hall of Fame Photo and Autobiography plaque. Hall of Fame members who registered in advance and attended the party received the original plaques honoring them that had been displayed on the walls of two local nightclubs. Those physical displays of Hall of Fame membership have been replaced with a virtual display on the FASA website: www.fasadance.com.

The evening also celebrated the current membership of the Hall of Fame with a slide presentation featuring a photo of each member, their name and year of induction and category of induction. A special notation was placed on the slides of those members inducted posthumously or who are deceased. After 25 years of inducting and honoring worthy shaggers the membership now stands at 80 Women, 81 Men, 34 Honorary and 29 Posthumous inductees for a total of 224 members.

Shaggers are inducted into the Hall of Fame in 4 categories: Women, Men, Honorary and Posthumous. This year's inductees included Rosemary Ramos Haney and Susan Bays Johnson (Women's

Category), Bob Dickerson and Gary Horne (Men's Category), Hollis Britt (Honorary Category) and Linda "Kay" Best Brooks and Edgar "Marvin" Johnson (Posthumous Category).

Rosemary Ramos Haney thanked her Puerto Rican parents who taught her to love music and dance which she began doing right after learning to walk. Her first date with her husband was at Williams Lake where he bopped while she shagged and they fell in love. **Susan Bays Johnson** attended college parties at fraternities and sororities at University of Kentucky and listened to great bands like "The Embers" and "The Tams" but never heard of the Carolina Shag until 20 years later. Friends steered her to a dance class where she became hooked even though she acknowledges she "came to the party so late in my life." **Bob Dickerson** was lured to beginner shag lessons after meeting two FASA members. It was there that Bob says he became entranced with the beat of "One and Two, Three and Four, Five Six!" Simple shag lessons led to Bob serving as FASA Vice-President and President. **Gary Horne** learned to love the Carolina Shag and the music through osmosis. His father owned "Steve's Tower in the Sky", a hang-out where kids danced to music spun by DJs high above the drive-in. Gary always had a front row seat to watch the action. Gary says his body may be older but he "finds a way to not let a good ole beach song go to waste." **Hollis Britt** is a fixture in the shag world. If he looks familiar it's because he worked at Judy's House of Oldies for 30 years. He is a Shag Icon, past Chairman of the SOS Enhancement Committee and a National Living Legend of Dance honoree just to name a new of his accomplishments. **Linda "Kay" Best Brooks** passed away far too young at age 49 but she made the best of the years she was given. She began to shag in high school and continued to be passionate about the music and dance her entire life. She is remembered for her warmth and gifts of listening and caring. Kay's husband, Clarke Brooks, accepted her honor on her behalf. **Edgar "Marvin" Johnson**, founder of the House of Raeford, was known as the "Turkey Man". To FASA he was known as a fervent supporter doing his part to keep the dance alive. He famously advised his granddaughters "not to marry a man who couldn't make money or dance." Marvin was represented at the ceremony by his son Bob Johnson.

No matter how long their involvement in the dance, all the inductees have one thing in common. They love the dance and the music but, most of all, they cherish the fellowship and friendships made because they have embraced the Carolina Shag. The Fayetteville Area Shaggers' Hall of Fame is proud to honor and highlight their achievements, memories and support of our dance.

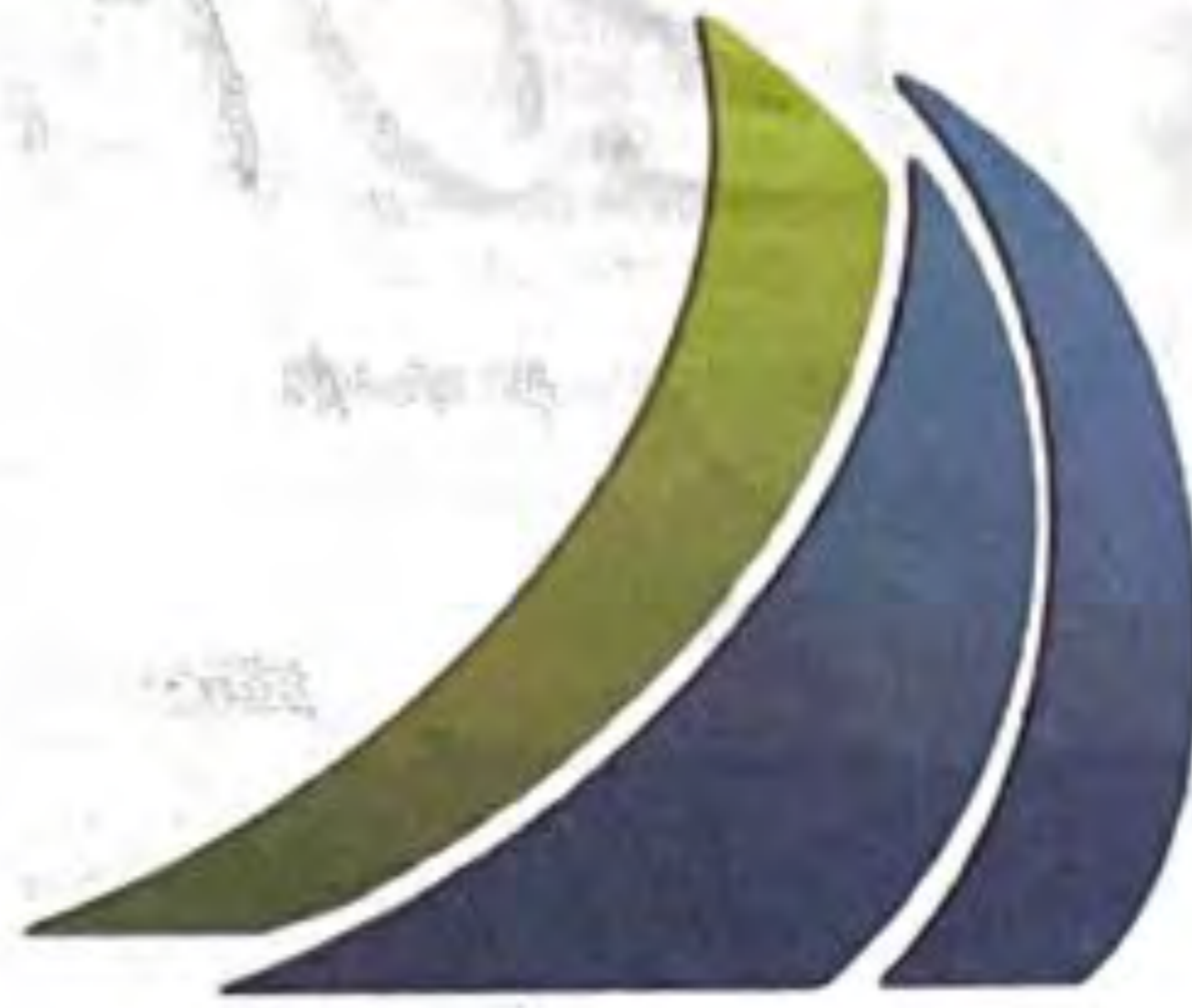

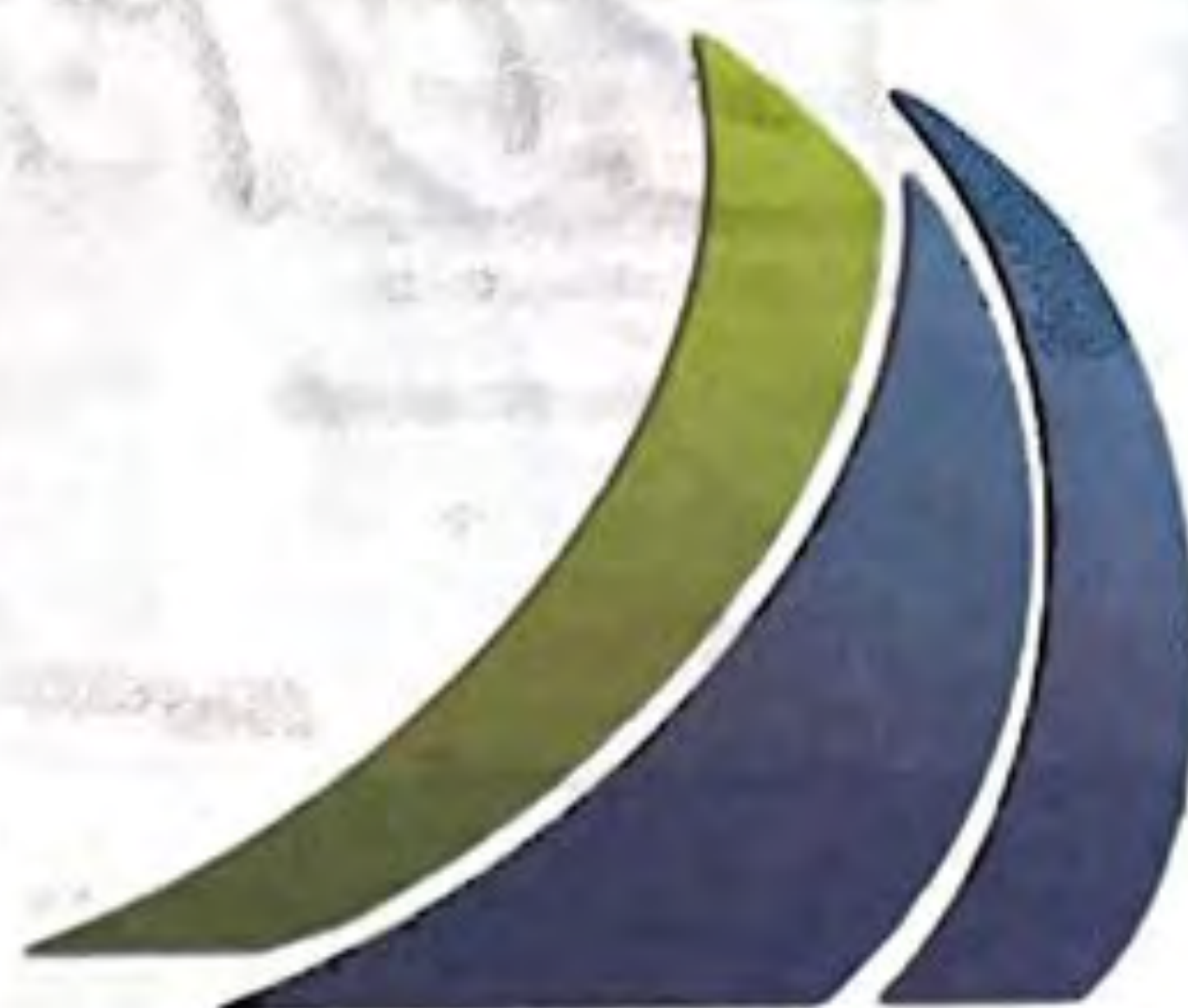
