It is very sad that most who shag today know very little, if anything about the history of the shag, the music, or the first fast dancers who made it possible for us to be here today. I wonder how many have any idea how long the shag has existed; when it was first called the shag; who the lifeguards were who spent their summers working at the beach living this incredible lifestyle; the history of the friendships that were made for a lifetime. The Ellen Taylor Foundation isn't a scholarship though we provide financial assistance to EVERY junior who applies for assistance for gas, lodging, food, etc. to attend Junior SOS, National Shag Dance Championships and Grand Nationals Dance Championships. Assistance is offered to all juniors twenty and under. The assistance form is on our website www.ellentaylorfoundation.org. Much gratitude from the ETF Board of Directors for your support these past twelve years. Without you we could not have assisted these juniors to attend Junior SOS and other junior related activities. Please pay it forward in your schools and local communities.

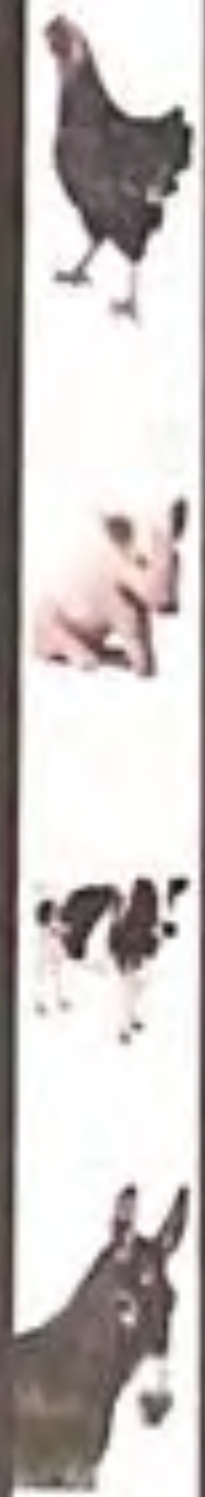

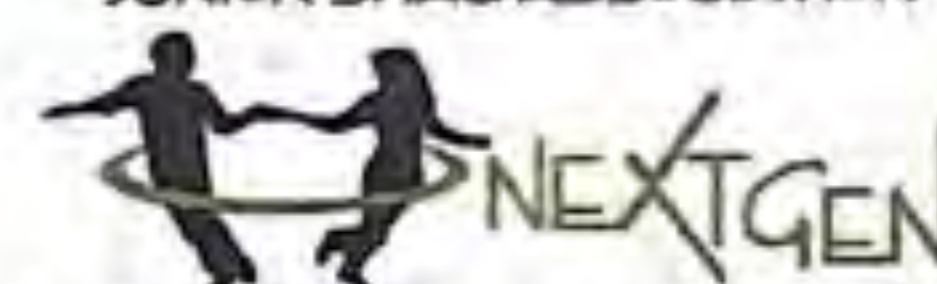

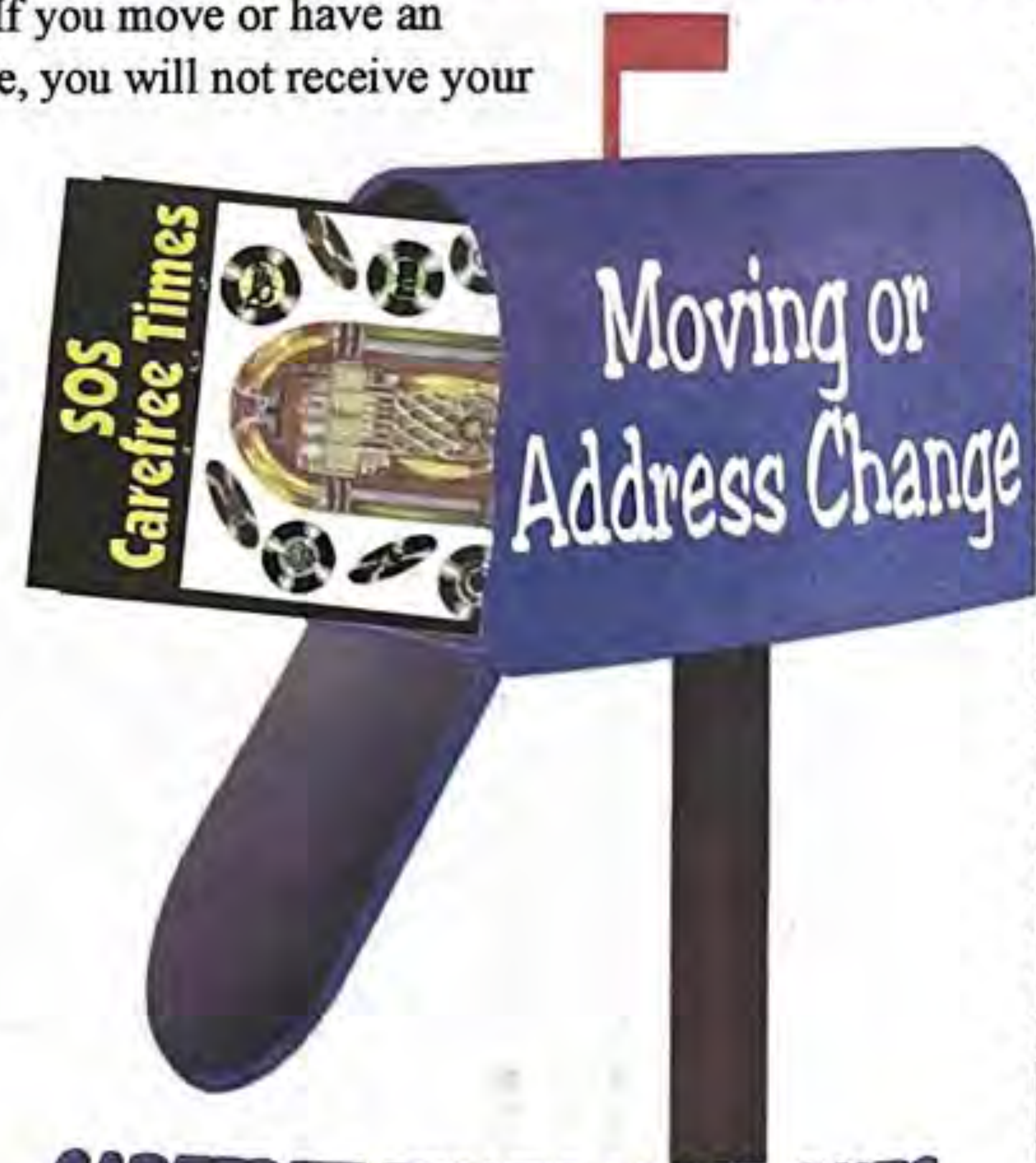

The 28th induction of honorees into the Fayetteville Area Shaggers' Hall of Fame was held on Saturday, June 22nd, at the Highland Country Club in Fayetteville, North Carolina. Six individuals were inducted in four categories.

The Fayetteville Area Shaggers' Hall of Fame was founded in 1992 to "recognize those associated with the Fayetteville area who have contributed to the dance, the music and the atmosphere surrounding the dance."

The Hall of Fame is planned and presented annually by the Fayetteville Area Shag Association Perpetual Board of Directors. They are Dwayne Baggett, Chairman, Dawn Carr, Secretary, Barbara Peele, Correspondence, Elsie Holden, Treasurer, and members Kathi Baloyot, Steve Dawson, Cathy Fann, Linda Wheeler Gurnik, Steve Miller, Joyce Ramos and David Sessoms.

Those inducted for 2019 are Allana Goodyear and Karen Butler Clemenger (Category Women), Norm Aldridge and Gary Wilson (Category Men), Dale Lasater (Category Honorary) and James "Jimmy" Honeycutt (Category Posthumous). Last year's Honorary Category Inductee, Bill Kirby, Jr., was also honored as he was unable to attend the 2018 ceremony. Each inductee has contributed, supported and greatly enjoyed being a part of the Carolina Shag.

Allana Goodyear claims "She Just Wants to Dance" as her theme song. She was born with dancing in her blood as she watched her Mom and Dad jitterbug for as long as they were able. A catchy tune will start her feet moving, even in the car. For that she thanks cruise control! Allana served two terms as FASA's Corresponding Secretary, a duty which opened her eyes to what goes into running a shag club. She's grateful to those who continue to work to keep the shag and clubs alive.

Karen Butler Clemenger was taught to shag at age 13 by her cousin Diane Honeycutt. Diane's brother, Robert Honeycutt, operated Williams Lake during that time. Karen managed to spend weekends with her cousins so she could dance at that place so famous in shag history. Karen enjoyed serving as FASA Treasurer and helping with parties. One of her best memories was participating in the SOS Parade on the FASA float with a hillbilly theme which featured a certain "outhouse" which later began popping up in the front yards of FASA members' homes with removal only when a fee was paid to FASA coffers.

Norm Aldridge traveled to Ocean Drive and other shag events as a young child with his parents. He entered his first dance contest in 1993 at Flaherty's in Fayetteville, North Carolina. After a win in that contest, he teamed up with Nikki Kontoulas to make a fulltime hobby of competitive dancing. In 1995, Norm teamed up with Kristal Taylor to enter the first ever Grand National Dance Championship. Norm stated that he credits his "many dancing accomplishments, of which I am proud, with helping to reinforce the all-American belief that one can accomplish

anything with perseverance, dedication, and hard work."

Gary Wilson caught the shagging bug in junior high school and continued dancing through college where fraternity brothers introduced him to practicing with the doorknob. After all those beginner lessons, Gary credits Don Bunn and Beverly Lewis Hall for giving the best shag lessons ever at a local Fayetteville lounge. Gary and wife Brenda continued to dance at FASA, SOS, the Old Timer's Parties in Fayetteville and many other events and places that played the music we love and grew up with. He still loves to dance.

Fayetteville native Dale Lasater started dancing the jitterbug with her father. During family summer trips to Ocean Drive, shagging was always on the agenda. Dale also hit the road to shag at White Lake, Williams Lake, and anywhere else she could dance. The famous "Old Timer's Party" in Fayetteville was a "must-attend" for Dale as she described it as a shag family reunion. She was an original member of FASA and says of her shag club friends, "We all grew very close, but time, age, and health changed things, but the good memories stay the same. Many of the people I met shagging are still a part of my life today."

James "Jimmy" Honeycutt's sister, Judy Honeycutt Appley, tells us he begged her to teach him to dance. Jimmy was a natural dancer who drew crowds of fans when he hit the wooden floors of North Myrtle Beach and other shag venues. Jimmy was a highly decorated U.S. Marine who earned three Purple Hearts, three meritorious combat promotions and a Silver Star for his service in Vietnam. His sister, Judy, remembers him in her mind's eye as "a blonde-haired lad with the deepest blue eyes you'll ever see and the biggest smile that always made me smile as well."

Bill Kirby, Jr. has written numerous articles about FASA, the Carolina Shag, local shag hangouts and shag world notables such as Eddie Monsour. Bill's autobiography, read at the induction ceremony, says it all, "How I have enjoyed telling the stories of your days from Williams Lake to 'The Hayloft' at White Lake, to the Myrtle Beach Pavilion to Ocean Drive's dirt floor or wherever a juke box spun a 45 rpm. Your stories are touching - from practicing with the doorknobs to your first dances together to so many who fell in love with not only the dance and the music, but one another."

Betty Ladwig, Shoe Chairperson of the Ellen Taylor Foundation and her committee of volunteers work tirelessly for the success of the Shoe Program. This program was added to the Financial Assistance program in 2008.

Although providing financial assistance to families with juniors to have the opportunity to attend Junior SOS was our primary concern our Board of Directors wanted to do more for these families and decided to add a program that collected gently used shag shoes to provide to any junior who was in need of shoes.

Betty's love of the juniors was the perfect person for chairperson of this program. Everyone who knows Betty will attest to the fact that she loves being busy. The saying "when you want to get a job done, ask a busy person", certainly applies to this lady. Betty was excited to be a part of anything that would benefit the junior and accepted this responsibility. She began advertising for gently used and in good condition shag shoes and collected approximately two hundred pairs of shoes. Tables were set up in the ballroom at the O. D. Resort Hotel, the home of Junior SOS and at the end of the weekend, over seventy percent of the shoes had been given to juniors. In comparison to the first year, moving forward to Junior SOS 2019, the Junior Shag Association provides two rooms at the hotel for the purpose of setting up the shoes, one room designated for the guys and the other for the gals. The week began with 700 pairs of shoes which had been collected throughout the year. At the end of the week three hundred seventy-five pairs of shoes in excellent condition were packed to be stored at the North Myrtle Beach Chamber of Commerce Warehouse for the year 2020. After the juniors have had the opportunity to select shoes each day, Friday is designated for the adults to go into the shoe rooms and purchase shoes which were left at a minimal fee. The monies collected go to the Ellen Taylor Foundation fund.

This process of collecting shoes and distributing them to the juniors may appear to be a simple responsibility. Betty and her team of volunteers collect shoes from drop off points

throughout the year. When the shoes are collected, they are cleaned, banded, packed according to size and boxed to be taken to the warehouse for storage until the next Junior SOS. Each year, Betty and her volunteers transport the boxes of shoes to the O D Resort shoe rooms which have been set up by some of the staff at the Resort and additional volunteers.

Words are not enough to express gratitude to Betty and all of the volunteers who work all year and give countless number of hours of time without asking for or expecting anything in return. Betty, thank you for these past eleven years and for your dedication to the Foundation. Volunteers, I won't attempt to name all of you for fear of leaving someone out but you know who you are. From me and the Board of Directors, thank you from the bottom of our hearts.
