GET IN SHAPE FOR THE S.O.S.™

Nine TIME-TESTED TIPS to help YOU Sharpen YOUR S.O.S. Survival Skills for the Big 1986 SPRING SAFARI!

NEWS BULLETIN ... Last August we reported that the Burlington Shag Club was holding an S.O.S. Training Party to get their Troops in shape. Carefree Times has learned that while the August S.O.S. training party was a huge success, the long range results of this operation were a dismal failure as many of the Burlington area S.O.S.ers either CRASHED at the Fall Migration or went into long periods of hibernation upon returning home. Following is sage S.O.S. survival advice that we sent to the Burlingtonians.

- 1. Attend all A.C.C. basketball games in your area and scream loudly (at the top of your lungs - don't just yell ... SCREAM) throughout every game.** Practice shouting and screaming after every play ... after every referee's call. Remember ... never whisper when you can talk. Never talk when you can shout.
