

Nomination of SOS Board Members

If you are interested in being considered for an SOS Board Member position you must apply for the position. The process for consideration is the following:

- Meet the required qualifications
- Evaluate your skills as compared to the recommended qualifications.

- Online submission is recommended

SOS Board members are elected 2 of every 3 years at the Winter Workshop. The next election will be at the 2021 ACSC Winter Workshop when two positions will be up for election. For the next election cycle all applications must be submitted online or postmarked by September 18, 2021 to be considered for office during the 2022 election cycle. The slate of officers will be presented at the ACSC Fall Migration Business Meeting on September 25, 2021, the election will be held on January 15, 2022. The duties of the SOS Board members are included in the SOS By-Laws Article 2, Section 2.
